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Cobb Scores on Iowa Assessments Top National Averages

Third, fifth, and seventh grade students in the Cobb County School District performed above the national average on the 2015-2016 Iowa Assessments, a set of norm-referenced tests that compare students' performance to that of their peers across the United States. Cobb third graders had an average composite score ranked in the 59th percentile, meaning that on average Cobb third graders scored equal to or better than 59% of all other U.S. third grade students who took the Iowa Assessments. Composite scores for fifth graders ranked in the 60th percentile, and seventh graders scored in the 59th percentile (See Table 1). The 50th percentile is the national average in all subjects tested. According to Cobb County School District Superintendent Chris Ragsdale, these scores are the result of the hard work performed by teachers every day.

The Iowa Assessments evaluate students in reading, English language arts, math, science, and social studies. The tests are particularly helpful in identifying core skills where students may need additional instruction. By administering the tests in the fall, teachers can utilize student data to improve instruction.

In Cobb County, third graders performed best in science, scoring in the 64th percentile, and in reading, where they ranked in the 59th percentile. Scores for Cobb fifth graders were at the 67th percentile in social studies and 63rd percentile in English language arts. Seventh grade students ranked in the 62nd percentile in English language arts, science, and social studies. In reading, they placed in the 57th percentile. Math for fifth and seventh grade students ranked in the 55th percentile. Social studies scores for third grade also ranked in the 55th percentile.

The following is the Cobb County School District's Testing Brief for the 2015–2016 Iowa Assessments. The testing brief contains the scores on all sections of the Iowa Assessments for the district. The brief also contains average scores for all elementary and middle schools in the district on all sections of the Iowa Assessments.



Testing Brief for the 2015–2016 Iowa Assessments

In September of 2015, the Cobb County School District administered the Iowa Assessments to all Cobb County School District students in Grades 3, 5, and 7. The Iowa Assessments are norm-referenced tests, which allows the performance of Cobb students can be compared to performance of students who took the same test at the same time across the United States. Students take the Iowa Assessments over the course of four school days in the subjects of reading, English-language arts, math, science, and social studies. In this testing brief, scores for each subject are reported using two measures: (1) national percentile rank and (2) grade equivalent.

National percentile rank or NPR communicates how a student’s performance compares to all students who took the test across the United States. A NPR of 60% means that the student scored better than 60% of the students who took the test nationally. Nationally the average NPR is 50%.

Grade equivalent or GE communicates how a student’s performance compares to how far along they are in school. GE is a decimal number. The digits before the decimal represent the grade level, while the digits after the decimal represent the month in the school year. Thus, a GE of 3.6 means that on the grade 3 test the student performed equivalent to what is expected for a student in the sixth month of the third grade.

Data Provided in this Testing Brief

This report contains the district and school averages for each section of the Iowa Assessments. The results are arranged in separate tables with scores in reading and language arts, mathematics and the core composite scores, and all subject scores and the complete composite score. Separate tables are included for each grade (3, 5, and 7). Tables are also provided showing the reading and math total scores for the last three years at each school.

The NPR and GE district and school averages reported in this document are not based on nationwide school averages but on student scores. Therefore, the NPR and GE in this report should be thought of as the NPR or GE of the typical or average student in the district or the typical or average student in the school.
