- 5. Collaborates with teachers and other instructional personnel in effective assessment strategies.
- 6. Plans and implements professional learning for teachers in effective instructional practices and district initiatives.
- 7. Coordinates the implementation of all GADOE, SACS, State, and Federal regulations related to the K-12 Health and Physical Education Program.
- 8. Supervises the middle school intramural program.
- 9. Coordinates the state required scoliosis screening with the Nursing Supervisor.
- 10. Assists the Textbook Supervisor with the selection of textbooks, supplementary materials, and instructional equipment and technology.
- 11. Plans, utilizes, and monitors the health and physical education budget.
- 12. Performs other duties as assigned by appropriate administrator.
