

## Milestones Testing Brief Cobb Middle Schools: 2017–2018

Georgia Milestones End-of-Grade (EOG) Assessments were given in the 2017–2018 school year for the fourth time. EOG assessments are given in grades 3 to 8 in English Language Arts and Math. EOG assessments are also given in Science, and Social Studies in grades 5 and 8. Some students take the high school courses Algebra 1 and/or Physical Science in 8th grade. In 2018, these students took the End-of-Course (EOC) assessment instead of the EOG assessment.

### Achievement Levels on the Georgia Milestones EOG and EOC Assessments

Student performance on the EOG Assessments is divided into one of four achievement levels: (1) Beginning Learner, (2) Developing Learner, (3) Proficient Learner, or (4) Distinguished Learner.

**Beginning Learners** These students did not demonstrate proficiency.

**Developing Learners** These students demonstrated partial proficiency.

**Proficient Learners** These students demonstrated proficiency.

**Distinguished Learners** These students demonstrated advanced proficiency

**Percent proficient** is the percentage of students scoring in the top two achievement levels. The Georgia DOE considers the percent proficient to correspond to those students who are ready to progress to the next grade in that test subject.

### Data Provided in this Testing Brief

The summary statistics of assessment results presented in this document are from EOG assessments taken during the Spring administration of the Georgia Milestones and all EOC assessments taken during the 2016–2018 school year. All summary statistics for the district presented in this testing brief were calculated from individual student test scores provided in the final data file from the Georgia DOE. In the following tables, groupings that contained fewer than 15 students were excluded to protect privacy.

The following tables include district- and school-level summaries of the performance of Cobb students on the Georgia Milestones EOG and EOC assessments. Comparisons are made to the state-level summaries where available.

Historical trends are shown for most test metrics from 2015 to 2018 in the following tables. The 1-year trend is calculated by subtracting the 2017 test metric from the 2018 value. Likewise, the 3-year trend is calculated by subtracting the 2015 test metric from the 2018 value.

For the historical EOC results in math, the EOC results presented for 2015 are from Coordinate Algebra; whereas, for 2016–2018 the results are from Algebra 1.
