# At ECMS...

Student Schedules: On their first day of school, students will receive a full schedule and report to 1st period. Please note, schedules are subject to change due to balancing.

Lockers: Will not be issued during the 2021-2022 school year. Backpacks and bags (drawstring, cinch sacks) will be permissible throughout the school day and in the classrooms. Rolling backpacks/bag are not permitted.

Busses: Parents can find bus information on the CCSD website (bus information and routes). Students can also check in the ECMS Guidance Dept. to find out which bus to ride and the bus schedule. At the end of the school day, buses will park in a specific lane. This lane will not change throughout the school year.

#### What if...

*I am absent?* Parent/guardian may call the attendance office by 9:30am on the day of your absence. On the day you return to school, bring a doctor's note or note from home stating the reason and dates of your absence and turn in to the attendance office. Excused absences can be accepted for personal and immediate family illness, death in the family and approved religious holidays.

*I am tardy?* School begins at 9:15am and after that time you are considered tardy. If you arrive at school after 9:15am, report to the main office and sign in. A parent must sign you in and/or send a note explaining the tardiness.

# Bell Schedule

ECMS follows both a block and traditional schedule throughout the week. Please refer to the website for specific daily schedules.

## Dress Code:

Advanced Content Classes: The following classes are offered as advanced content: AC English and Language Arts, AC Science, High School Science, AC Social Studies. East Cobb also offers ADV Math and Accelerated Math. To participate in these classes students must meet various criteria based on gifted identification and/or previous standardized testing scores. To continue participating, a student must maintain an 80 or higher in the course during the semester and many courses require a minimum test average. Placement requirements are subject to change and vary by class. Students cannot be waived into classes by parents at the middle school level; students that do not meet the criteria will be evaluated at the end of the year for advanced classes for the following school year. The advanced placement committee evaluates every rising 6<sup>th</sup> grader & new student before they are placed. Criteria is on our website.

# **Dromotion Criteria**

- (1) Pass math, ELA and one additional core subject for the year and demonstrate minimum proficiency on the appropriate state-adopted assessment in math, ELA and one additional core subject.
- (2) Earn a combined overall passing average for all scheduled courses for the year; and
- (3) Demonstrate an appropriate level of reading comprehension as measured by Lexile score.
