

DISTRICT ADMINISTRATIVE RULE

RATIONALE/OBJECTIVE:

The Cobb County School District (District) maintains teaching and learning resources in the Cobb Teaching and Learning System (CTLS). See the organizational structures for the delivery of instruction referenced in Board Policy IB (Instructional Program Goals and Objectives) and Administrative Rule IE-R (Instructional Arrangements).

RULE:

A. GUIDELINES:

- Educational program content and its instructional objectives should be maintained in the CTLS.
- 2. These teaching and learning resources should:
 - a. Include the content found in the Georgia adopted standards; and
 - b. Be developed by teachers and other professional staff members under the coordination of District teaching and learning supervisors.
- 3. The District's teaching and learning resources should be:
 - a. Available digitally on the CTLS;
 - b. Made available to classroom teachers; and
 - Followed in the process of classroom instruction as the basis for each program of study offered.
