Important Information

- The is a formal event.
- Large bags/purses, backpacks, drawstring bags, etc. **WILL NOT** be allowed into the venue.
- If you are under the influence of drugs or alcohol you will NOT be allowed to enter prom and will be turned over to campus officers.
- All students, including guest must show your school ID at the registration table along with your ticket(s) to enter.
- Tickets will be distributed in homeroom on Wednesday, April 20th.
- A signed Guest Approval Form must be completed/approved by Mr. Gillihan or designee before you will receive your ticket.
- **Guest Approval forms must be submitted to Admin IV by Friday, April 15, 2022. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- You must sign a prom contract before you can receive your ticket(s).
- If you receive and/or have received 10 days of OSS of more during the Spring 2022 semester, you will not be allowed to attend the prom. You should not purchase a ticket and if you decide to purchase a ticket, it will not be refunded.
- You must be present at school on Friday, April 22, 2022 for at least half the day in order to attend prom.
 - Early check-outs or absences on this day will make you ineligible to attend prom. Tickets will not be refunded.
- **All library fines must be cleared before you can receive a prom ticket.**

FAQ's

- Is food served at prom?
 - Snacks/Beverages will be served
- If I get suspended and am no longer able to attend prom, can my ticket be refunded?
 - No, refunds will not be issued.
- Is parking covered in the cost of my prom ticket?
 - No, parking is an additional cost if you choose to park in Atlantic Station.
Hourly rates are listed below:
0 – 2 hours: free
2 – 3 hours: \$4.00
3 – 4 hours: \$6.00
4 – 5 hours: \$8.00
- Where do I park?
 - You will want to park near entrance 10 (light green) or entrance 16 (teal)
- When will I get my prom ticket?
 - In homeroom on Wednesday, April 20, 2022
- Where do I get a Guest Approval Form?
 - Forms are available in the Counseling Suite, Main Office and outside of Mrs. Edwards Office(155)
- Can I run out to my car to grab something and then come back into the prom?
 - No. If you leave the venue for any reason, you will not be allowed to re-enter.
- Who's in charge of prom?
 - Ms. Lewis in Room 205 is the Prom Coordinator and Mrs. Edwards (Room 155) is the Prom Admin.
