REQUIREMENTS TO EARN A SERVICE CORD AT GRADUATION!

- ***200 hours total**
Accumulate 200 hours of community service from 9th-12th grade
 - ***Covid Flexibility**
Because of lack of availability or service opportunities over the past few years we have lowered the requirements. (2022- 100 Hours, 2023- 100 Hours, 2024- 150 Hours, 2025- 200 Hours)
 - **At least half with a Lassiter organization!**
100 of the hours (or more) should be associated with a Lassiter school club, team, or organization
 - **Outside hours**
100 hours could be associated with any non-profit group, hospital, church or community organization
 - **Online Tracking**
Use x2vol to track your hours throughout high school! We will pull the final list at graduation. (instructions below)
 - **Transfer student?**
Accumulate 50 hours per year that you are at Lassiter!

- **Log in to Naviance**

- **Click on x2vol**

- **Log in or create account**
If you have never logged hours create an account and then let your counselor know so we can approve you!
- **Add hours!**
Start a new project, enter details, attach any documentation, and enter email address of sponsor
- **That's it!**
Sponsor will verify hours and then counselors will approve. You can track your total throughout high school and use to help you fill in applications for jobs, college, scholarships!
