The Cobb County Department of Transportation (Cobb DOT) and Cobb County School District (CCSD) are committed to the safe and efficient movement of traffic and pedestrians within Cobb County School zones. The Ed-SPLOST project to rebuild Osborne High School and construct the new Cobb Innovation & Technology Academy (CITA) provided an opportunity for Cobb DOT to work with CCSD to improve traffic safety and operation in this school zone.

Cobb DOT SPLOST and Ed-SPLOST funding was used to implement traffic safety and operation improvements along Favor Road, Windy Hill Road and Kennedy Lane, including the addition of turn lanes to increase queuing capacity, a main entrance/exit to accommodate all vehicle turn movements on Favor Road, an additional right-turn-only exit on Favor Road, wider and continuous sidewalks, and a new, higher visibility crosswalk. Traffic signal and other school zone improvements also were included.

Starting August 3, 2020, vehicles will use the main entrance on Favor Road to access the student pick-up/drop-off location. Exiting vehicles will have the option to access Favor Road using the right-turn-only exit or the main school driveway, which has the added benefit of multiple exiting lanes (see aerial map on the back side for details).
