

Georgia Gun Laws:

Unless specifically authorized or exempted by law, persons may not possess, carry or have within their control any weapon or explosive compound of any kind as defined by Georgia Law **O.C.G.A. 16-11-127.1** while on school property, in a building attending a school function or on a school bus. In accordance to **O.C.G.A 16-11-129**, a person who possess a valid Georgia Weapons Carry License (GWCL) and in possession of a weapon, may travel through a school safety zone while dropping off or picking up a student. This refers to “curb side only”. **O.C.G.A 16-11-127** requires that firearms and weapons are to be stored in a locked container, compartment or a locked firearm rack in privately owned vehicles parked unattended at any school district facility. No student may possess weapons of any kind as defined by Georgia Law **O.C.G.A 16-11-127.1** while on school property, in a school building, attending a school function or on a school bus. Students are subject to criminal and administrative sanctions for violations.
