LOCATION OF VENUE AND DIRECTIONS

Cantrell Stadium is located on the campus of McEachern High School at 2400 New Macland Road, Powder Springs, GA 30127. From Macland Road turn south onto New Macland. From Richard D. Sailors Parkway turn north onto New Macland. Additional approach information and alternate routes are available on the district website (www.cobbk12.org/graduation).

PUBLIC HEALTH MEASURES

The Cobb County School District (CCSD) considers the health, safety, and overall well-being of students, teachers, staff, and guests to be of paramount importance. While COVID-19 continues to impact our communities, measures must be taken to implement required public health guidance. The District will adhere to guidance from local, state, and federal authorities and follow the guidance of the Cobb and Douglas Public Health Department.

All graduates and guests must comply with the necessary public health measures required at the time of the ceremony. SENIOR REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- All students are required to have on file a completed Clearance of Fines and Fees Form. Senior clearance will be conducted <u>May 19 & May 26 (Last Names A-L from 9:00 a.m.-</u><u>11:30 p.m. and Last Names M-Z from 11:30 a.m.-2:00 p.m.</u>).
- <u>Students will receive four (4) graduation tickets upon submission of completed</u> <u>Clearance of Fines & Fees Form.</u>
- All fees must be cleared by <u>May 26</u>. Students with outstanding fees will be prohibited from participating in the ceremony.
- *Honor Cords*: Cords for honor graduates (students with a 3.5 or above GPA-not rounded off) will receive their cords during senior clearance.

COMMENCEMENT PRACTICE

Seniors must attend the **MANDATORY** virtual practice on May 27 at 10:00 a.m. to participate in the commencement ceremony. The link will be emailed and posted on the CHS Website prior to practice.

COMMENCEMENT DAY INFORMATION – Tuesday, June 1

- Graduates report directly to the <u>HPEW Gym</u> at <u>7:00 a.m.</u> for attendance verification and lineup for the processional.
- Graduates are to park in the Taylor Farm parking lot using the entrance on Brand Road.

- Guests with disabilities and elderly guests needing individualized assistance should enter the campus of McEachern High School at either the north entrance on New Macland Road or the northwest entrance on Gaydon Road. Accessible parking will be available in front of the Performing Arts Center.
- All ticketed guests, including those with disabilities or elderly guests requiring individualized assistance, will enter Cantrell Stadium through the north gate and west gate located on the north and west sides of the stadium. Gates will open at **8:00 a.m.** for all guests.
- Guests will park in any available lot using entrances on New Macland Road and Gaydon Road. Overflow parking will be available off-site. Directions will be available on the district website (www.cobb12.org/graduation)
- All graduates and guests must comply with the necessary public health measures as required at the time of the event.
- Graduates should not bring personal items to commencement such as cell phones, keys, purses or selfie-sticks. There is <u>no place</u> to secure these items while you are participating in the commencement ceremony.
- Bag checks may be conducted by the CCSD Police Department as deemed necessary.
- <u>Prohibited Items for Graduates and Guests</u>: Balloons, posters/signs, camera tripods, monopods, selfie-sticks, or other camera stabilizing devices are not permitted inside or outside of the venue. In addition, any object which obscures the view of others or impacts the safety of others is not allowed in the venue.

CEREMONY BEHAVIOR

- Throwing caps is inappropriate, dangerous, and will not be permitted. If a student tosses a cap during the ceremony or during the recessional, the student will pay restitution for any damages incurred. Please understand that disruption and misconduct in any form will not be tolerated.
- Any senior who causes a disturbance or in any way conducts himself or herself inappropriately during the ceremony will be removed and will not receive their diploma on the day of graduation.

CAPS and GOWNS

- To participate in commencement ceremony each graduate must purchase the approved cap and gown through Herff Jones (<u>www.herffatlanta.com</u>).

DRESS FOR GRADUATES WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

 - White dress shirt
 - Black pants
 - Black shoes
 - Black socks
- Ladies:
 - Solid colored dark dresses (length no longer than the gown and collars should not show) or black dress slacks
 - Simple small jewelry (no necklaces)
 - o Dark dress shoes (no white hosiery and no silver/gold on the shoes
 - NO FLIP FLOPS, tennis shoes, house shoes, slippers or shoes with sparkles/bling are to be worn.
 - If you decide to wear high heeled shoes, **please wear a comfortable pair** for walking and standing for long periods of time.

Parents will not be permitted to interrupt the commencement ceremony to replace shoes that are uncomfortable.

Note: Mortarboards are to be placed on the top of the head so that the mortarboard is flat on the top. Bobby pins are suggested to hold the hat in place. Tassels are to be worn on the right side of the mortarboard during the ceremony.
