STEM Nights at Publix Tonight and Next Week

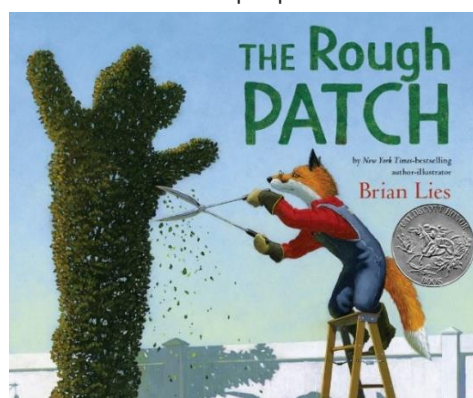
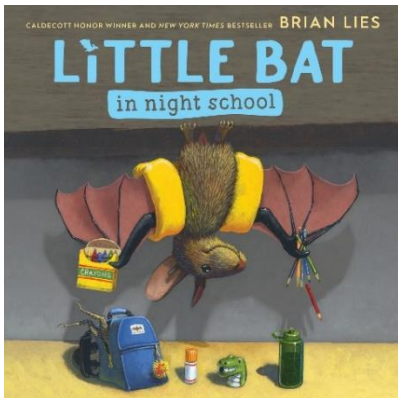
