#### Tech Tip


Wait Until 8th Pledge:
Taking a pledge to wait until 8th grade before getting your child a smartphone is a decision that many parents make to set boundaries around screen time and exposure to technology at a young age. The "Wait Until 8th" pledge involves  $delaying \ giving \ a \ child \ a \ smartphone \ until \ they \ reach \ 8th \ grade, typically \ around \ 13 \ or \ 14 \ years \ old. \ Parents \ do \ this \ to$  $promote\ developmental\ readiness, set\ protective\ boundaries,\ and\ encourage\ face-to-face\ interactions.\ It's\ a\ personal$ decision based on family values and concerns. Parents who take the "Wait Until 8th" pledge often find it helpful to communicate their decision with other parents. This can help foster a supportive community and reduce pressure on children to have smartphones at a younger age.
