Wait Until 8th Pledge-Insights for Tech Executives

Many leading tech executives, including those from companies like Apple and Microsoft, choose to delay giving their own children smartphones until they are older. For example, Steve Jobs famously limited his children's access to technology at home. These executives understand the potential downsides of early smartphone use, such as distraction, reduced face-to-face interaction, and exposure to inappropriate content. Their decision to set strict boundaries for their own families highlights the importance of carefully considering when to introduce smartphones to children. By following their lead, parents can feel more confident in their choice to wait until 8th grade, knowing that even those who create these technologies recognize the benefits of delaying their use.
