Tech Tip

Last week we shared some trusted resources for internet research. This week let's look at encouraging your child to think critically at websites.

1.Encourage Critical Thinking: Teach your child to evaluate the credibility of online sources. Discuss the importance of checking the author's credentials, examining the publication date, and verifying information across multiple reputable sources.

- .com = commercial (caution... look critically to evaluate)
- . .org = organization (usually non-profit)
- . .edu = educational institution (usually educational institutions)
- . .gov = government agency (safe, but is the content age appropriate?)
- 2. Set Clear Guidelines: Establish clear guidelines for internet usage and research. Encourage your child to ask for permission before exploring new websites and remind them to report any inappropriate content they encounter online. Do not forget the kid friendly browsers that were shared previously.

By fostering digital literacy skills and promoting the use of validated resources, we can empower our children to navigate the online world confidently and responsibly.
