



READY, SET... READ![12 TO 24 MONTHS FAMILY CHECKLIST AND GUIDE]

FAMILY CHECKLIST:

- Are your child's books sturdy board books that they can carry?
- Does your child have books with photos of children doing familiar things like sleeping and playing?
- > Do you read to your child goodnight books at bedtime?
- * Do you have books about saying good-bye and hello?
- Are you reading books with only a few words on each page?
- * Are the books you read to your child brightly colored, with engaging illustrations?
- Do the books include simple rhymes or predictable texts?
- * Does your child have touch-and-feel books?
- Do you have books about animals of all sizes and shapes?

TIPS FOR FAMILIES:

- Provide a variety of books to expose your child to lots of information.
- Read books that are appealing with big words, beautful pictures and bright colors. Pop-up books, textured books, books that make noises, etc. are great books to stimulate and keep your baby engaged.
- Allow your child to play with the books while reading to encourage exploration and develop book handling skills needed for early literacy.
