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## Tech Tip

March is the perfect time for some digital spring cleaning! Help protect your child online with these quick steps:

Week 4: Digital Citizenship Chat

A great reminder for kids (and adults!): Kindness and safety matter online. Here's how to guide the conversation:

- Ask your child: "What would you do if you saw someone being mean online?"
- Remind them: If you wouldn't say it face-to-face, repeat it to your parent, and don't type it online.
- Check privacy settings together on their favorite apps.
- Teach the STOP rule: If they see something upsetting online, STOP, don't respond, and tell an adult.
   A quick chat can go a long way in helping kids be responsible and respectful digital citizens.
