
## **FAMILY CHECKLIST:**

- \* Are you reading books to your child that tell simple stories?
- Do you have books for your child that include simple rhyming books that they can memorize?
- \* Are you reading bedtime books?
- Do your child's books include books about counting, the alphabet, and shapes or sizes?
- Do you have books about animals, vehicles, and playtime?
- Does your child have pop-up books, pull-the-tab books, and touch-and-feel books?
- Are you reading books to your child that have humorous pictures and words?

### TIPS FOR FAMILIES:

- Provide alphabet books, counting books, books about shapes, numbers and familiar things.
- Stimulate and keep your child engaged by reading pop-up books, textured touch-and-feel books, and books that make noises or sound effects.
- Point out what is observed in the books and allow your child to do the same to further shape your child's knowledge and learning experiences.
