Digital Learning Days

CTLIS has improved how Cobb students learn and how teachers teach. During the 2024-2025 school year, CCSD has designated Digital Learning Days (previously Asynchronous Learning Days) to allow teachers the chance to participate in professional learning. On these days, students will learn at home through CTLIS and not report to Keheley.

Digital Learning Days

- August 19, 2024
- October 14, 2024
- March 3, 2025

OVERVIEW
On Digital Learning Days, you can expect the following:

- Students will work from home, through CTLIS, on teacher assigned choice boards and other posted activities within their Digital Classrooms.
- Teachers will have reviewed expectations with students prior.
- Teachers will not host live, face-to-face instruction on these days.
- Students will post work in CTLIS or bring assignments into the school the following day.

DAILY ASSIGNMENT EXPECTATIONS
All Grades K-5 will have 30-minute assignments, that students should be able to complete independently, posted in CTLIS in each of the following subjects:

- Reading/Writing
- Science or Social Studies
- Math
- Specials (select one specials)

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Make sure your student has access to CTLIS.
- Elementary students can expect around 2 hours of total work per day that can be completed at their own pace and schedule.

REQUIREMENTS
All work will be housed in CTLIS and will be published for student access by 8:00 a.m. on the Digital Learning Day.

SPECIALS SCHEDULE
Each of our special teachers will post activities in their digital classrooms. Students are encouraged to login to the specials of their choosing to complete activities.

TARGET
If your child is scheduled for Target on a day that is declared a Digital Learning Day, he or she should log into his/her Target teacher's class in CTLIS. The Target teacher will post assignments on the class board in CTLIS.


FERQUENT CONCERNS

- Communicate any issues or concerns with your child's teacher.
- Try your best to complete tasks, but do not worry if all items cannot be completed.
- Do not stress over assignment, device, or internet issues.

Safety Reminders

Each day, the safety of our students, staff, and parents is our priority. While we understand waiting can be difficult, please realize that keeping everyone on campus safe is more important than the few extra seconds gained by not following our procedures. It is of the utmost importance you follow our traffic protocols each day.

Please remember to adhere to our simple and safe carpool rules:

- 1. Students load and unload on the right hand side only.** This prevents the risk of being hit by a passing car that is not following protocol. Also, staff cannot see around cars to the other side.
- 2. Drivers wait until cars move, not not go around cars that are still loading.** This prevents the risk of running into other cars, people, and cones.
- 3. Follow the directives of our staff working carpool.** Our staff is well trained on when to stop cars and help pedestrians cross the walk.
- 4. Pull all the way forward to the end of the loop and to the car in front of you to allow for the maximum amount of cars in the parking lot at a time.**
- 5. Be respectful to all.**
