## Wait Until 8th

Taking a pledge to wait until 8th grade before getting your child a smartphone is a decision that many parents make in order to set boundaries around screen time and exposure to technology at a young age. The "Wait Until 8th" pledge involves delaying giving a child a smartphone until they reach 8th grade, typically around 13 or 14 years old. Parents do this to promote developmental readiness, set protective boundaries, and encourage face-to-face interactions. It's a personal decision based on family values and concerns. Parents who take the "Wait Until 8th" pledge often find it helpful to communicate their decision with other parents. 
