HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarships

What is HOPE/Zell Miller?

These are scholarships that are awarded to Georgia residents who have demonstrated specific academic achievements. These scholarships assist students with paying for their tuition at any USG, TCSG, or eligible private colleges or universities in Georgia. The criteria varies for each scholarship; however, this is a great way for students to get help with paying for their post-secondary education!



HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarships

HOPE SCHOLARSHIP

- Be a U.S. Citizen or meet non-citizen requirements
- Must be a Georgia resident for at least one year
- Must graduate from a Georgia High School
- Must pass 4 rigor classes
- Must have a minimum of a 3.0 HOPE GPA upon graduation

Covers a portion of tuition!



HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarships

ZELLMILLER SCHOLARSHIP

- Be a U.S. Citizen or meet non-citizen requirements
- Must be a Georgia resident for at least one year
- Must graduate from a Georgia High School
- Must pass 4 rigor classes
- 3.7 HOPE GPA
- 1200 SAT (Math and Reading) or 26 ACT (Composite)

Covers full tuition!



HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarships

What are rigor courses?

Some graduation requirements qualify as rigorous courses. As you are registering for 11th and 12th grade, keep these courses in mind. Example of rigor courses are:

- Math (Advanced Algebra, Precalculus)
- Science (Physics, Chemistry)
- AP Classes
- Dual Enrollment classes
- Foreign Language (Level 2 and higher)



HOPE/Zell Miller Grants

HOPE GRANT

- Be a U.S. Citizen or meet non-citizen requirements
- Must be a Georgia resident for at least one year
- No GPA requirement
- Test scores not required
- Eligible for students working towards a certificate or diploma at a technical college

Covers portion of tuition!



HOPE/Zell Miller Grants

ZELL MILLER GRANT

- Be a U.S. Citizen or meet non-citizen requirements
- Must be a Georgia resident for at least one year
- No GPA requirement
- Test scores not required
- Must earn a 3.5 GPA after first semester at post-secondary institution
- Eligible for students working towards a certificate or diploma at a technical college

Covers standard tuition rate!



HOPE/Zell Miller Grants

HOPE CAREER GRANT

- Must be a recipient of HOPE or Zell Miller Grant
- Eligible for students working towards a certificate or diploma at a technical college in programs that are in high demand career fields

Fixed award amount based on program
and number of enrollment hours.



HOPE GPA and Transcript

HOPE GPA= The average of your core classes (English, math, science, social studies), foreign language classes, and some computer science classes!

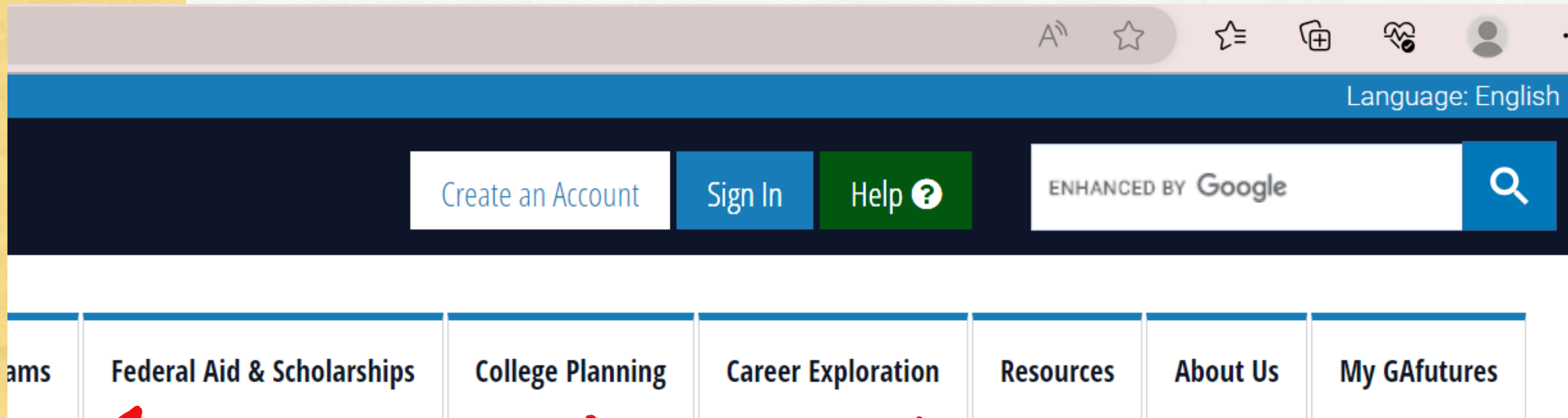

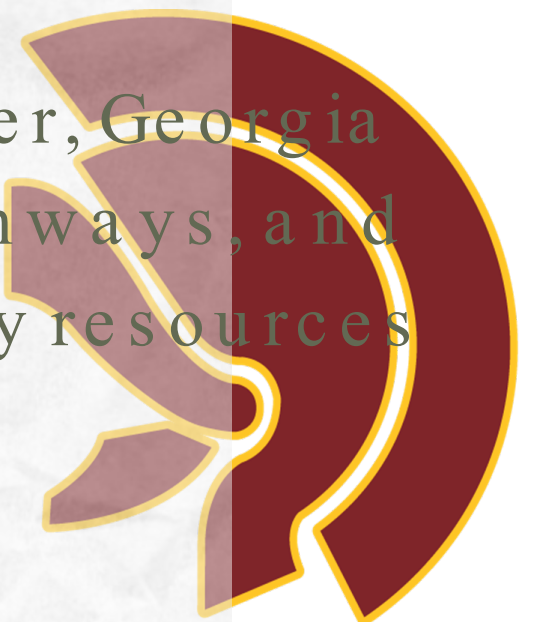

What is the SAT/ACT? Why are they important?

The SAT and ACT are standardized tests that colleges use to determine how prepared you are to take college-level courses. Depending on the institution and your high school GPA, the college/university might require these tests for admissions. The SAT and ACT can also open the door for scholarships!



SAT

PSAT

- Should have taken exam October, 16th.
- Scores are available in your Collegeboard account.
- Prepares you for the SAT.
- Visit Collegeboard to take additional practice tests!
- Can register to take junior year, too!

To access your PSAT scores and register for the SAT, visit CollegeBoard.org!

SAT

- Register through Collegeboard.
- Has 4 sections: Reading, Writing, Math with a calculator, and Math without a calculator.
- Typically offered here at Lassiter on Saturdays.
- Keep in mind any deadlines when registering!

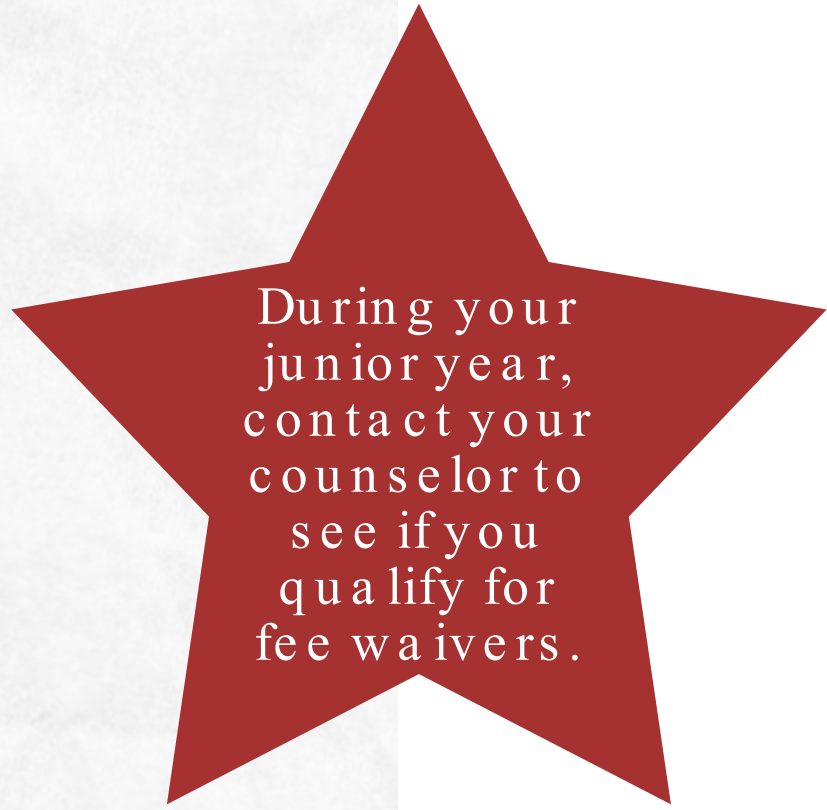

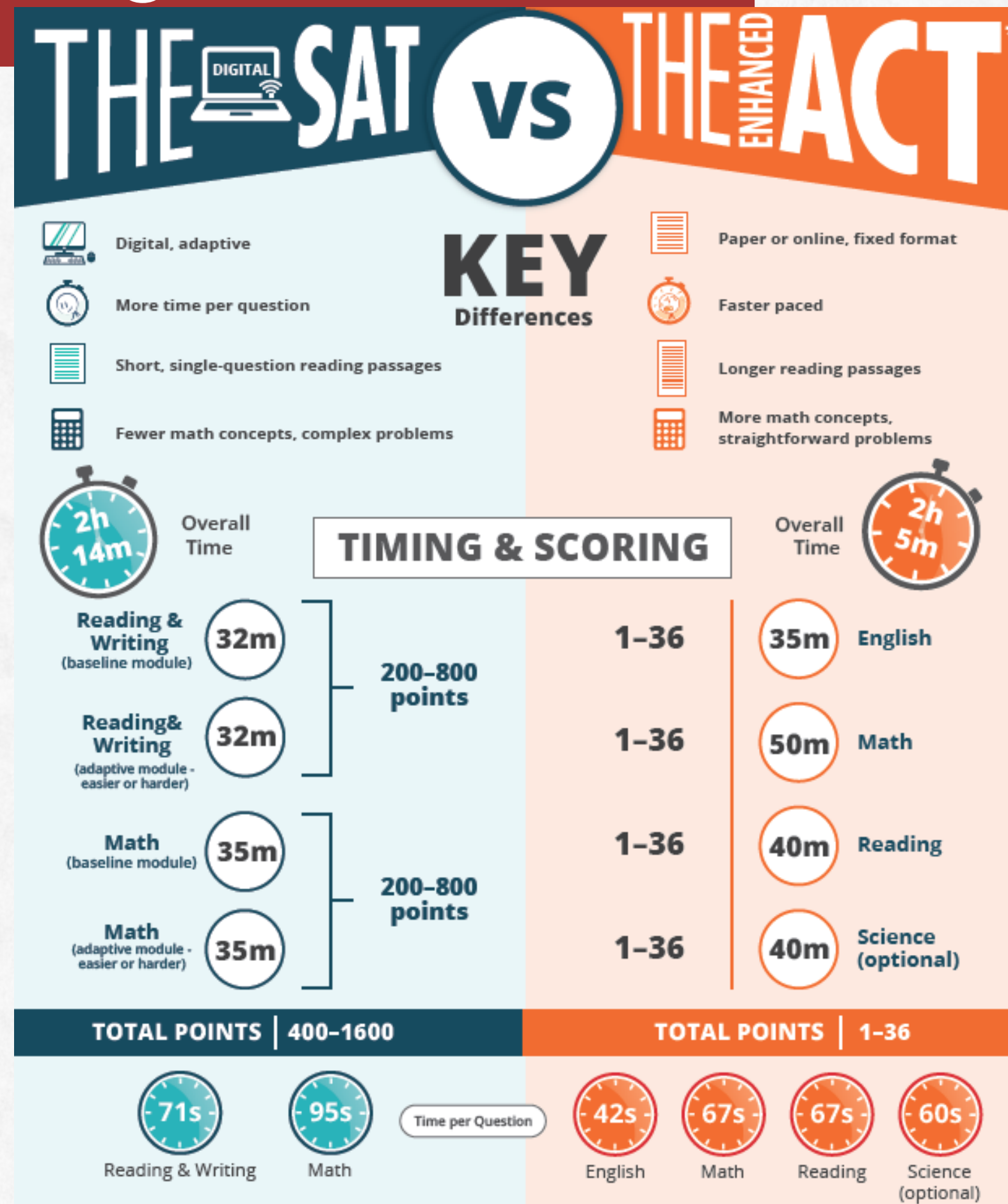

Which exam is right for me?



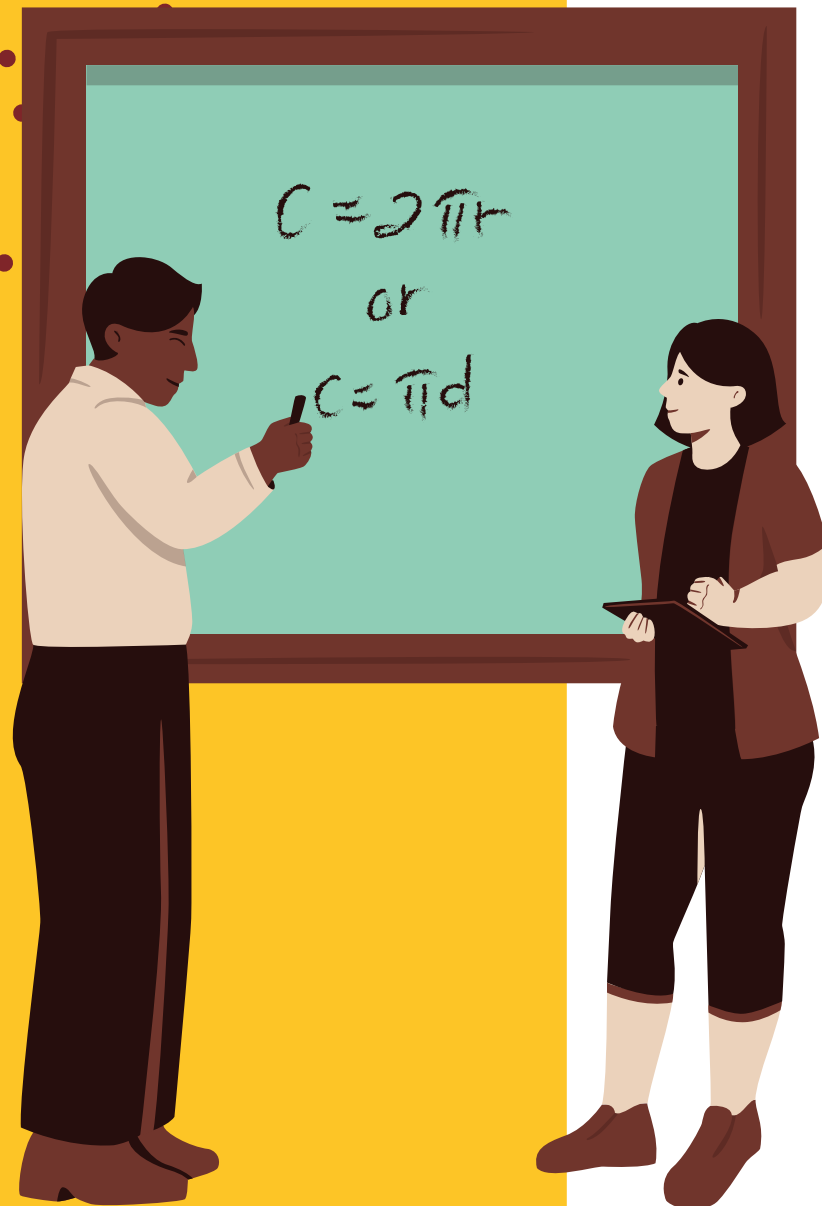
ASVAB

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is an exam that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military. This exam is available to all students who seek information about their skill set.

Exam is January 13th at 9 AM during schoolday, but you can take as a Junior!

What is Dual Enrollment?



Dual Enrollment is a state-funded program that allows you to take college-level courses while completing your high school diploma.

This program pays for 100% of tuition, mandatory fees, and any required textbooks.

You can earn up to 30 credit hours!

Basically... You are able to earn college credits while still in high school!



Dual Enrollment

Dual Enrollment provides limited options for 10th graders.

1.

Any 10th grader is able to take a CTAEC class at a Technical College.

2.

Those 10th graders who earn a 1200 SAT or 26 ACT (in one sitting) are able to apply to participating Dual Enrollment programs.



Dual Enrollment

Interested in Dual Enrollment?

- Reach out to your counselor and set up an appointment
- Mandatory Parent Night – February 26th at 6 PM
- Deadline for all documents – May 1st



Dual Enrollment

Important things to consider...

- Will your college of interest accept these credits?
- DE vs. AP
- Full time vs. Part time participation
- Transportation to the college might be necessary
- Scheduling conflicts
 - In-school and extra curricular responsibilities
- Cobb County and College calendars are different
 - Breaks, exam dates, etc.



Dual Achievement



Dual Achievement program (DAP) (established by SB 204) offers qualified students an alternate path to high school graduation. Students choose to simultaneously earn a high school diploma and two (2) Technical Certificates of Credit in a specific career pathway, a Technical Diploma*, or a college Associate Degree*. Students must be between the ages of 16 - 21 and have earned 6 high school credits.

Complete all required high school courses:

2 English Courses
2 Math Courses
2 Science Courses
2 Social Studies Courses
1 Health/PE



Complete any of the following Technical College Credentials:

- Two TCCs from the list on Page 3
- Any one Diploma Program* from the list on page 4
- Any one Associate Degree*
