GEORGIA MATCH



- GEORGIA MATCH is a simple way for you to know where you are eligible for admission (to be admitted to college), based on your high school calculated HOPE grade point average (GPA) through 11th grade.
- Note: GEORGIA MATCH works with public and private accredited high schools in Georgia only.
- A senior's GEORGIA MATCH colleges are found on one's <u>GAfutures Student</u> Dashboard.

Requirements aren't the same...

High School Graduation

- Determined by GA Department of Ed (DOE)
- Tracked by you, your teachers, and your school counselor
- Are needed before you earn a diploma
 you graduate if you earn the minimum
- Includes 23 required credits in specific areas

College Admission

- Determined by the individual college
- Tracked by you it is your responsibility to find out what the school wants
- Are needed before you can be accepted you may not be accepted with just the minimum
- Includes SAT, ACT, Accuplacer

Kell SAT Prep Program

- SAT Review will be after school for 1.5 hours
 - Sept 9, 11, 16, 18, and 30; Oct 2, 7, and 9
- \$100 for the 8 sessions, pay on Mypaymentsplus.com (registration limited to 22)

Paying for College (Financial Aid)

- Scholarships
 - Do not have to be repaid.
- Federal Student Grants
 - Exceptional financial need and who have not earned a bachelor's or graduate degree
 - Do not have to be repaid.
- Federal Work-study
 - Provides part-time paid jobs for students with financial need.
- Loans (Federal & Private)
 - **Do** have to be repaid and typically include the amount borrowed <u>plus</u> interest.

Paying for College – HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarship

HOPE Scholarship

Basic eligibility requirements:

- Graduate high school with a minimum 3.0 calculated HOPE GPA
- Earn a minimum of four (4) full rigor credits from the Academic Rigor Course List
- Meet U.S. citizenship or eligible non-citizen requirements

Zell Miller Scholarship

Basic eligibility requirements:

- Graduate with a minimum 3.7 calculated HOPE GPA
- Earn a minimum of four (4) full rigor credits from the <u>Academic Rigor Course List</u>
- Earn a qualifying test score on a single administration of the ACT or SAT prior to high school graduation.
- Current Test Score Requirements:
 - SAT: 1200
 - ACT: TBD equivalent ACT composite score determined on January 15th

Due Dark and Light Scholarship

9/20 Seeks to help first-generation, BIPOC students from Georgia so they can continue their education and achieve their dreams. Any high school senior from Georgia who is BIPOC and will be a first-generation college student may apply for this scholarship. Amount: 5500



Gates Scholarship

Highly selective, last-dollar scholarship for outstanding, minority, high school seniors from low-income households. Amount: full cost of attendance that is not already covered.

Paying for College – HOPE/Zell Miller **Grants**

- <u>HOPE Grant:</u> Available to Georgia residents who are working towards a certificate or diploma at an eligible Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG) **or** *Select 5 access University System of Georgia Institutions.
- HOPE Career Grant: Available to HOPE Grant-qualified students who enroll in select majors specifically aligned with industries in which there are more jobs available in Georgia than there are skilled workers to fill them. These industries have been identified as strategically important to the state's economic growth.
- Zell Miller Grant: Available to Georgia residents who are working towards a certificate or diploma at a Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG) **or** *Select 5 access University System of Georgia Institutions.


Paying for College – HOPE Program FAQ

- How to apply for the HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarship or Grant?
 - -Complete the FAFSA (Annually) or
 - -Complete the GSFAPP (Valid for 10 years)
- What's my HOPE GPA?
 - -Viewable from the Your HOPE GPA tab from logging in to your GA Futures profile
 - -Not the same as your CCSD weighted or unweighted GPA
- It is recommended to frequent the GAFutures website for the most up-to-date and official information about the HOPE program.

Your Social Security Number (SSN) <u>must</u> be on file in the Cobb County student record system in order to receive any HOPE/Zell Miller funds!






