

Harrison High School 2023-2024 Elective Registration Worksheet

Directions: You will use this worksheet to guide you as you enter elective choices in StudentVUE.

Use the list of courses attached (or below if viewing digitally) to select your elective requests. Once you log into StudentVUE, **pay attention to whether you are scheduled for Health/BPE and/or Spanish II/H Spanish II in the Fall (Y) or in the Spring (B).** You will need two top electives for both Fall (Y) and Spring (B). If you are already scheduled for Health/BPE and Spanish II/H Spanish II in one semester, you will choose two top electives for the other semester. If you are scheduled for Health/BPE one semester and Spanish II/H Spanish the other semester, you will select one other top elective each semester. If you are only scheduled for Health/BPE, select one top elective for the semester you are scheduled to take Health/BPE and two top electives for the other semester. Fall courses have a Y behind their name and Spring courses have a B behind their name. Enter your top elective choices and their course numbers in the Top Electives table below.

Note: Health & Personal Fitness is a required class for graduation, and all 9th grade students are enrolled in this course.

Choose 4 alternates, two for Fall (Y) and two for Spring (B). Enter your alternate choices and their course numbers in the Alternate Electives table below. Use this worksheet as a guide to help you enter your choices in StudentVUE.

Note: Choose your electives carefully. It is our hope that all students get their top choices; however, you may get one of your alternate choices.
