
What is a School-Parent Compact?

Smitha Teachers

Post to CTLS Learn each Math Unit guide with glossary and online resources to support student comprehension of math terminology.

Provide parents with Delta Math and Progress Learning access information for students to deepen Math content understanding through home practice.

Provide parents Dreambox access information for students to address misconceptions and achievement gaps through home practice.

Post via CTLS, ELA Unit guides with vocabulary resources to support students in understanding writing concepts.
