ACADEMICS

STEM Program

The Kell STEM Academy is designed to give students the chance to pursue advanced opportunities in the four broad areas of STEM – Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math.

• Engineering and Technology students achieved a 100% EOPA Pass Rate for the 2022-2023 school year!

AP Program

Advanced Placement (AP) Courses offer students the chance to experience the rigor of college-level content and course work as well as the opportunity to earn college credit before ever leaving high school!

- The Kell High School AP Program offers 28 different AP courses, including the rigorous AP Capstone program.
- In 2024, Kell HS earned the distinction of an AP Honor School, earning honors in four distinct categories, including both Humanities and STEM.
- Kell has also been recognized as an AP Computer Science Female Diversity School

AVID Program

The Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) program is a cohort elective serving students all four years of their high school experience. This program uses and promotes instructional practices that create a college-going culture that increases the number of students who enroll and succeed in higher education and their lives beyond.

FINE ARTS

Band, Orchestra, Chorus, Drama, and the Visual Arts make-up our Performing Arts department. In addition to continuously achieving excellent and superior ratings at yearly evaluations and offering opportunities for students to perform and show artwork across the state and southeast, these programs continuously produce students who earn county and state-level accolades.

- Seven Orchestra students made the District 12 Honor Orchestra in 2023.
- The Kell Marching Band received numerous 1st in-class and 2nd Overall awards in the 2023 season.
- Kell Concert Band had seven students accepted to the Georgia All-State Band.
- The Visual Arts program had two representatives in the 2023 Capital Art show and a GHP State finalist.
- Seven chorus students were selected to the 2023 county Honor Chorus, and two had the honor of singing the National Anthem at the Northeast Cobb Business Association Luncheon in 2023.
- The Kell chorus, drama, and art teachers all earned District Teacher of the Year in their respective content areas for the 2022-23 school year.

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ATHLETICS

Kell boasts 16 different sports program offerings for its student body, and it has a long history of athletic achievement that includes not just numerous post-season appearances but State Championship titles too:

- Nine State Championships in the sports of Softball, Girls Lacrosse, Boys Track, and Girls and Boys Basketball.
- State Runner-Up placements in Girls Lacrosse, Girls Tennis, Girls and Boys Basketball, and Girls Track.

The Fall/Winter 2023 sports season was no different in our athletic achievements:

- Our Varsity Softball team saw a Final Four appearance
- Football claimed the Region Championship for 2023
- Lady Longhorns Volleyball was the region runner-up and went to the final four in the state championship
- Kell diving had a 4th place state finish in the GHSA diving championships
- Our Girls Flag Football team made a playoff appearance in only their second season as a program
- Girls Varsity Basketball was the region runner-up and went to the Sweet 16 round of the state championship
- Boys Varsity Basketball won the State Championship for the second year in a row!
