# **HILLGROVE HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE 2023-2024**

#### **Athletic Accomplishments**

Hillgrove athletics compete in the highest classification 7A in the state of Georgia. Our teams include Cross Country, Tennis, Basketball, Soccer, Lacrosse, Volleyball, Football, flag football Swimming, Wrestling, Baseball, Softball, Track/Field, Golf, and Cheerleading. Our athletic teams have competed in both region and state tournaments and boast numerous region championships and recently added state championships in flag football and girls track. Our athletes have earned athletic scholarships to compete at the next level. It also is an honor for Hillgrove Athletics to have some alumni to go on and have professional careers.

#### **Navy JROTC Accomplishments**

Hillgrove's Navy JROTC is a civic-based leadership development program that allows students to grow as leaders and servants in their local community, with cadets completing roughly 3000 hours of community and school service annually. Hillgrove NJROTC has been a Distinguished Unit with Academic Honors for 10 straight years and is one of the top ranked programs in the state of GA and nationally. NJROTC competes in Academics, Air Rifle, Athletics, Drone, Military Drill, and Orienteering with numerous regional, state, and national championships titles. The Academic Team won the 2018 State Championship, and the Drill Team was State Runner-up in 2023. The Orienteering Team has won the 2018, 2020, 2021, 2023, and 2024 State Championships, as well as the 2019, 2022, and 2023 National Orienteering Championships in Agua Dulce, CA, San Jose, CA, and Winder, GA, respectively.

#### **Fine Arts Accomplishments**

The Hillgrove Fine Arts programs have earned recognition for their achievements at the state, national, and international levels. The Visual Art program actively supports the National Art Honor Society and regularly displays student work in exhibitions from local to national stages. The Drama program maintains a vibrant chapter of the International Thespian Society, showcasing their talents at various conferences and competitions. The band, orchestra, and chorus programs are proud participants in the GMEA State Conference, with the Marching Band achieving finalist status at Bands of America. The Wind Symphony was a national winner at the Wind Band Honors Competition and has been selected to perform at the 2025 National Concert Band Festival. Additionally, the Hillgrove Jazz Orchestra has performed at the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago, Illinois, and the Jazz Educators Network Conference in Atlanta, Georgia. Hillgrove's Bands and Orchestras have also embarked on international concert tours in China, France, and Iceland. Notably, the Symphony Orchestra has performed at national festivals in prestigious venues such as the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C., Orchestra Hall in Chicago, and Carnegie Hall in New York.
