<u>Georgia Medicaid</u> administers several waiver programs that help people who are elderly or have disabilities remain in their homes or communities instead of a hospital or nursing home. One of these programs, the Community Care Services Program (CCSP), offers a range of community-based services to support individuals with physical disabilities. Participants must meet the same medical, functional, and financial criteria as for nursing facility placement under Medicaid and be approved by a physician. The name of the agency that oversees Medicaid in Georgia is the **Georgia Department of Community Health.**





Family Support Services

Family support funding is not income-based, but it is based on each family and individual's unique needs. Individuals cannot already be receiving services through the NOW or Comp Waivers.





Eligibility Criteria:

- Three years of age or older.
- Documentation of an intellectual or developmental disability prior to age 22.
