### 4x4 Block Scheduling

Four, 90-Minute Blocks; M-F; Semesters:  
S1 or S2: 18 Weeks (1 unit of credit)  
Q1, Q2, Q3, Q4: 9 Weeks (.5 unit of credit)  
FY: 36 Weeks (1 unit of credit) Final grades are posted at the end of each 18 week semester, except for FY classes, which post at the end of the school year.

### Class Rank and GPA Calculation

CCSD does not numerically rank students. GPA is cumulative for four years and includes all classes. CCSD utilizes a weighted 4.0 GPA scale, in that some courses receive additional quality points due to the level of difficulty. Additional quality points are calculated into the cumulative GPA and are not reflected in numerical averages:

A = 4.0 B = 3.0 C = 2.0 D = 1.0 F = 0

### One additional quality point for completing:

Any AP or IB course  
Any 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, or 6<sup>th</sup> year language

### One half (.5) additional point for completion of Accelerated, Honors, or Pre-IB level course
