- Official High School Transcript
- Homeschool Portfolio (if applicable)
- Submit official college transcript (if previously Dual Enrolled)

☐ Complete the Dual Enrollment New Student Form

- Student submits the form and parent receives an email invite to approve

☐ Submit Official Test Scores and AP Scores

☐ Complete DE Funding Application

ADMISSIONS DEADLINES

DUAL ENROLLMENT FUNDING



- **Submit your funding application through GAFutures.**
 - Submit for the correct academic year (i.e 2026-2027)
 - You, your supporter, and HS counselor must complete your portion of the application to receive DE funding for the semester.
- **The DE funding cap is 30 credit hours (~10 classes) and will pay for 15 or less hours per semester.**
- **Funding pays 100% of a student's tuition, student fees, and book rental in only approved courses.**
- **Approved courses - GSFC DE Directory.**
 - Core Academic Areas (English, Math, Science, Social Science, and World Languages/Computer Science).
 - Career, Technical, and Agricultural (CTAE) Courses.
- **Fine Arts, Physical Education, and Health are not eligible for DE funding**





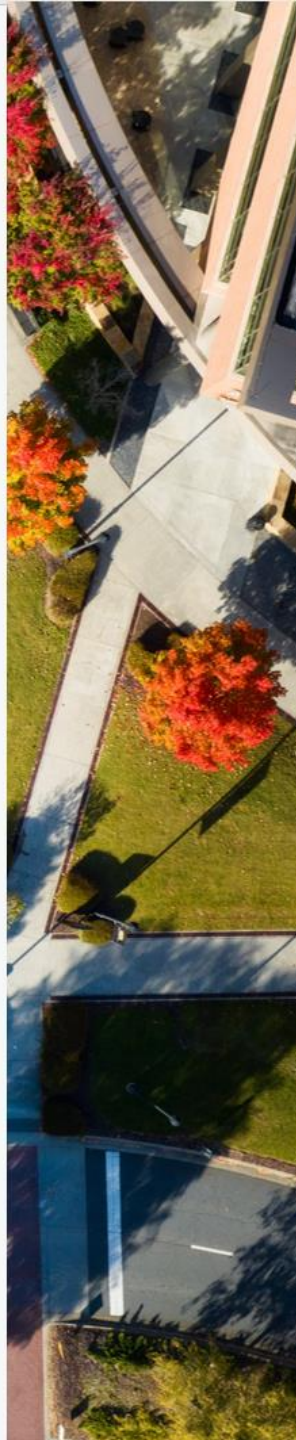
DUAL ENROLLMENT FUNDING (CONT.)



GAFutures Funding Eligibility:

Effective Summer term 2026 and later for Residency:

- A student must be a United States Citizen, born or naturalized, or a Title IV Eligible Non-Citizen according to the Federal Student Aid Regulations as of the first day of classes
- SSN is required on all new funding applications (i.e., 2026-2027)
- Students must answer U.S. Citizenship questions on the funding application
- Students must answer Georgia Residency questions on the funding application
- **Course Retake & Withdrawals**
 - No funding is awarded for the same course taken twice.
 - Students are ineligible for funding after their 2nd course withdrawal.
- All course changes must be updated on funding application.



DUAL ENROLLMENT FUNDING

(continued)



YOUR RESPONSIBILITY:

- Course lab fees
- Scantrons
- Non-funded courses & self-pay courses
 - Responsible for tuition, student fees, and books
- Parking (if you are attending in-person or hybrid)
- Meal plans (optional)



AFTER ACCEPTANCE



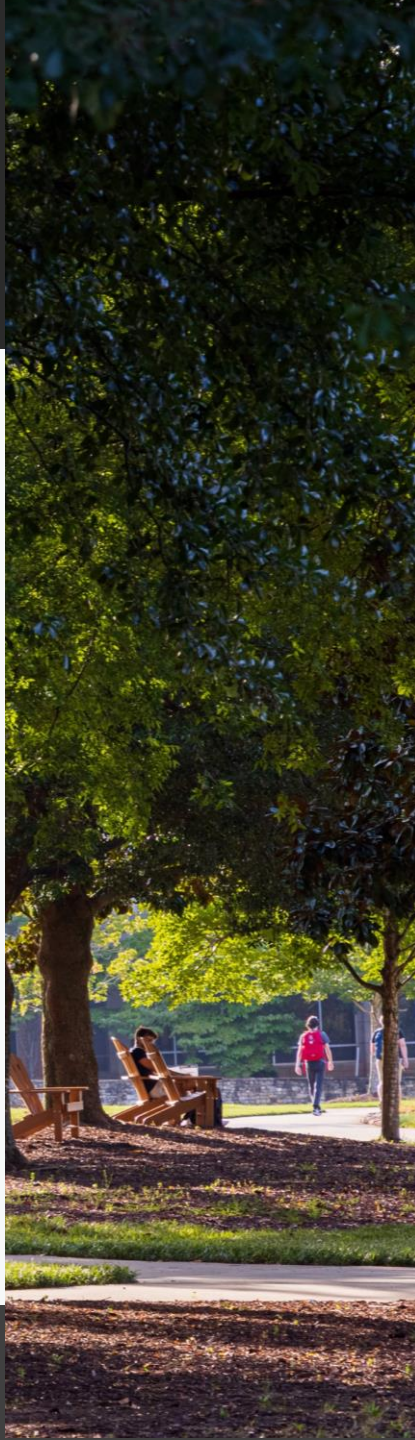
YOUR RESPONSIBILITY:

- Set up your NET ID, Duo Authentication, KSU Email, and Owl Express
- Sign up for mandatory Dual Enrollment Orientation
- Complete your Lawful Presence Verification (LPV) form
- Attend your Dual Enrollment Advising Appointment
- Complete your Dual Enrollment Funding Application



REMINDERS:

- Meet with your high school counselor to determine your DE classes
- Make sure to select KSU as your college when completing the funding application
- **Your funding application is not the same as your DE College admission application**
- Use your campus resources for tutoring if you are falling behind in classes
- A KSU GPA lower than 2.0 is an automatic dismissal from KSU's DE program
