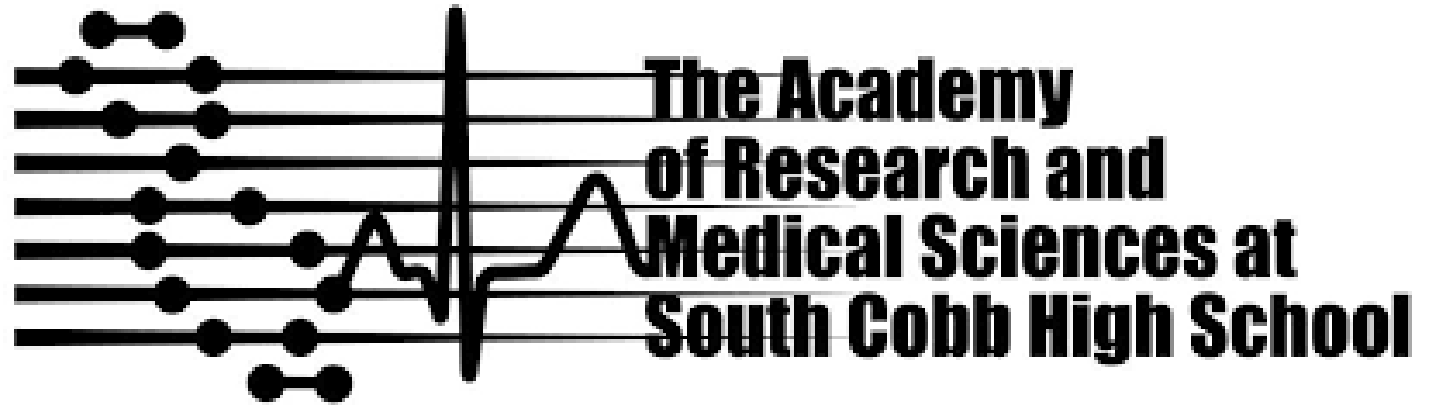

- There is ONE application website for all five academic magnet programs. *Pebblebrook & CITA are now in the same portal!!*
- Applicants will be evaluated on demonstrated strengths in the following areas:
 - ♦ Middle school grades
 - ♦ Teacher recommendations
 - ♦ Standardized test scores
 - ♦ Discipline Records
 - ♦ PSAT 8/9 (Academic Magnet Programs)
 - ♦ Audition Scores (CCCEPA)
 - ♦ Written communication skills
 - ♦ Attendance

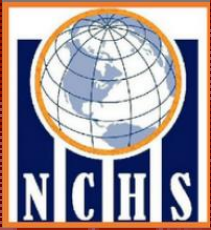

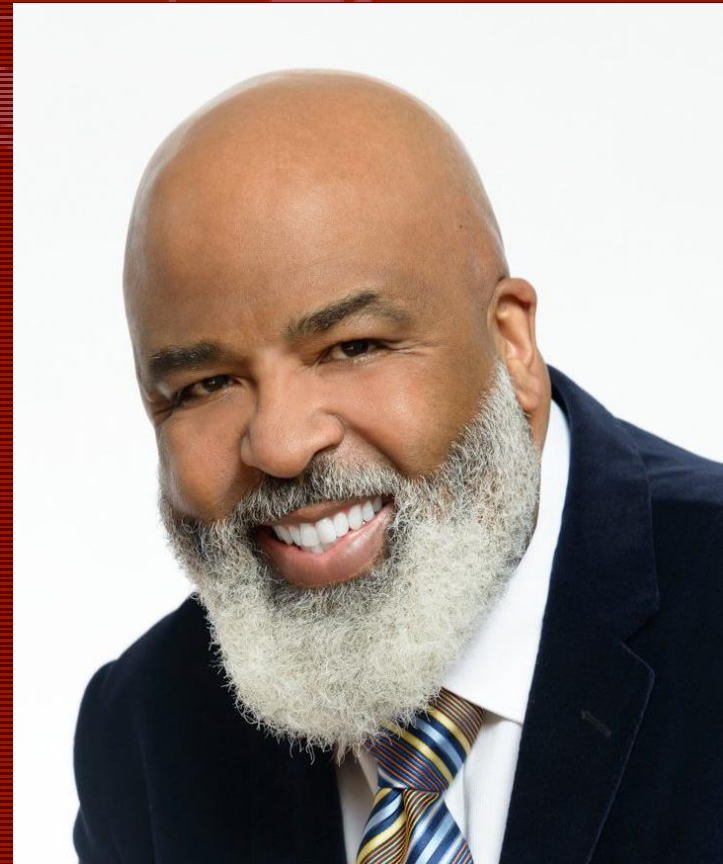
