- <u>Gifted Identified Students Only</u> As required by the state DOE, all gifted students will receive services in at least one advanced content (AC) class in an area of strength.
- All placements are contingent upon teacher allotment, the current population served, and available space per class each year.
- Successful completion of AC content courses (maintaining 80% or higher) is required for continuation to the next grade level.
- Maintaining an 80% or higher is required to continue in every AC course. If a student does not maintain an 80% each quarter, the student will be placed on Academic Probation for one quarter. If 80% is not maintained for three total quarters, the student will be removed from the AC course. This is the requirement for all AC courses in all subject areas.

The local eligibility committee will consider placing additional students in Tiers I and II of the AC classes according to the following:

- Questions about student scores can be answered by students' teachers, grade level counselors, or administrators.
- Where applicable, teacher recommendations should come from subject area teachers in student's current grade level, or previous grade level if student is transferring from another **middle school**.
- Classes must have seats available after all students meeting initial requirements are placed.
- Determination will depend on the student's total qualifications in any area compared with other students being considered for placement in the same grade and content area.
