Alternate/Transition Diploma Post-secondary Options

Inclusive Post-secondary Education (IPSE)	IPSE Programs provide a college experience for students who would not traditionally be able to access college. Most programs do not lead to a college degree.	• GAIPSEC.org • Thinkcollege.net • <u>Community Resource Guide: Post-secondary Education</u>
Certification Program	Certification programs are programs that train for a specific job without requiring additional academic study. Many have a hands on component.	<u>Chattahoochee Tech Workforce Certificates</u>
Job Training Program	Job training programs often include soft skills training in addition to job specific training. Certification may or may not be part of the program. There is often assistance with job seeking or placement built into the program.	<u>Community Resource Guide: Employment</u>
Apprenticeship	Combines paid on-the-job training with classroom instruction to prepare workers for highly-skilled careers.	<u>Apprentice Georgia</u>
On the Job Training (OJT)	OJT is a hands-on method of fostering job specific competencies within the workplace. Training is usually paid and takes place in the work environment, with other employees, using the work tools associated with the job.	• <u>Ken's Krew</u> • <u>GVRA</u>



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Supported Employment	Support for maintaining a job varies based on the need of the individual but can include periodic job coaching on/off site, regular observation or supervision of the individual, and contact with family, or other person/agency to stabilize the job placement.	<u>Georgia Vocational Rehabilitation Supported Employment</u>
Volunteer	Individuals may choose to volunteer in order to support their community. Volunteer opportunities are available in many areas, including faith based organizations, charities, animal care, and senior services.	<u>Volunteer Match</u>
Day Program/ Individual Community Access	Day programs allow for a community setting for individuals who need more assistance throughout their day. Individual community access may be provided to an individual who is not able to be a part of the group setting in a day program.	<u>Community Resource Guide: Extensive Support Needs</u>



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
