

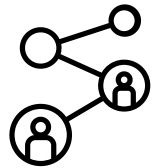

Family Support Services

Family Support Services provide funding to assist families in obtaining disability-related goods and services. Family support funding is not income-based; it is determined by each family's and individual's unique needs. Individuals cannot already be receiving services through the NOW or Comp Waivers.



Eligibility Criteria:

- Three years of age or older.
- Documentation of an intellectual or developmental disability prior to age 22.
