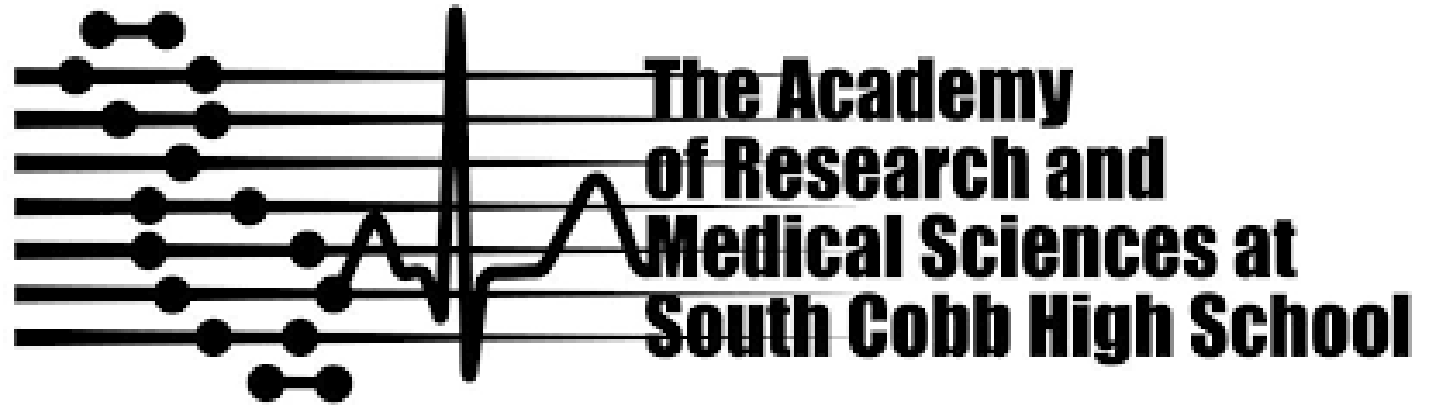

Admissions



- 8th grade students are eligible to apply for freshman admission into any magnet program.
- To apply, students must be in the 8th grade and in the Cobb County School District
- There is ONE application website for all magnet programs. *CCCEPA requires an audition/interview in the addition to the application.*
- Applicants will be evaluated on demonstrated strengths in the following areas:
 - ♦ Middle school grades
 - ♦ Teacher recommendations
 - ♦ Standardized test scores
 - ♦ Discipline Records
 - ♦ PSAT 8/9 (Academic Magnet Programs)
 - ♦ Audition Scores (CCCEPA)
 - ♦ Written communication skills
 - ♦ Attendance

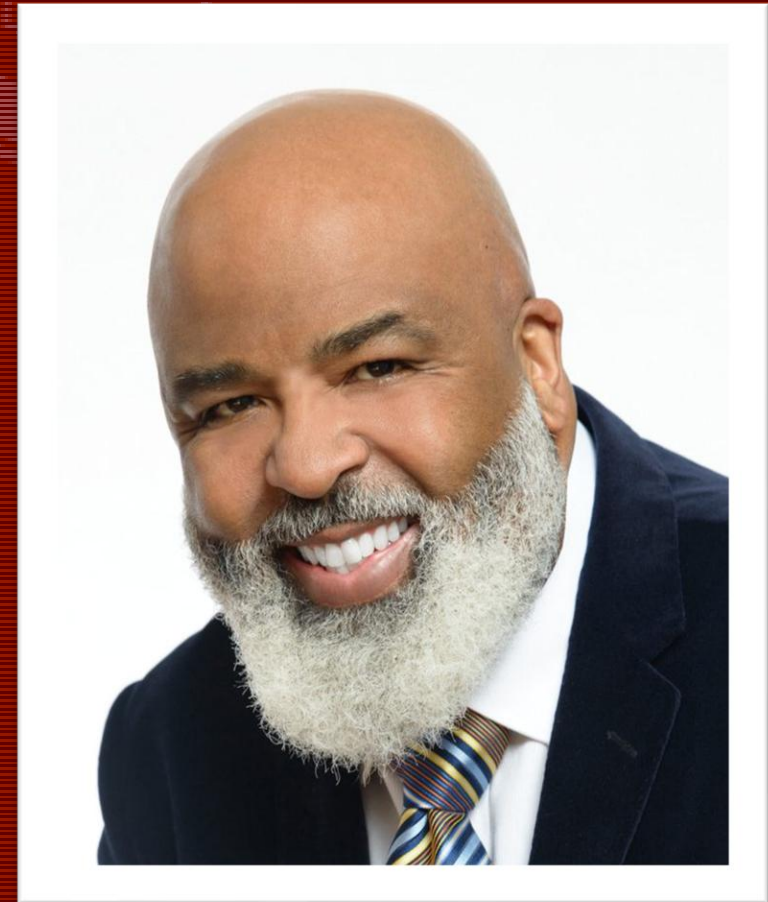
