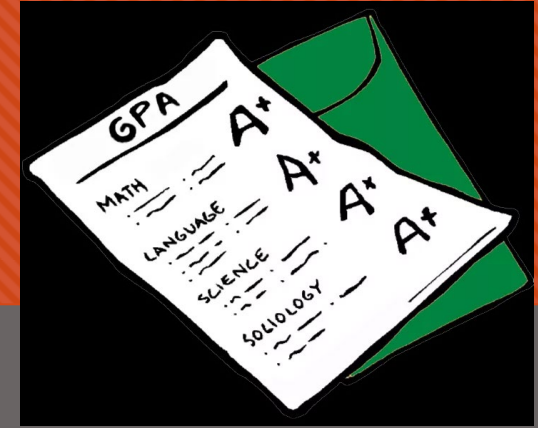

Language Arts- 4 credits required

- 9th grade: Lit and Comp 1, H Lit and Comp 1
- 10th grade: Lit and Comp 2, H Lit and Comp 2
- 11th grade: Lit and Comp 3, H Lit and Comp 3, AP Lang
- 12th grade: Lit and Comp 4, H Lit and Comp 4, H Dramatic Writing, AP Lit

Math- 4 credits required

- 9th grade: Algebra, H Algebra, Geometry, H Geometry
- 10th grade: Geometry, H Geometry, Adv Alg, H Adv Alg
- 11th grade: Adv Alg, H Adv Alg, Pre-Calculus, AP Pre-Calculus, AP Calculus
- 12th grade: Pre-Calculus, AP Pre-Calculus, AP Calc or AP Stat

Social Studies- 3 credits required

- 10th grade: World History, H World History or AP World History
- 11th grade: US History, H US History or AP US History
- 12th grade: .5 credit of American Gov or AP Gov
.5 credit of Economics Or AP Econ

**** 9th grade Social Studies (Humanities and H Humanities are the foundation for success)**

Science- 4 credits required

- 9th grade: Biology, H Bio, H Chemistry
- 10th grade: Earth Systems, Chemistry, H Chem or AP Biology
- 11th grade: Physics, AP Physics or AP Chemistry
- 12th grade: AP Physics, AP Env. Science, AP Chemistry, AP Computer Science, H Anatomy/Phys, H Forensics, Zoology, Env Sci

Health and Personal Fitness- 1 credit required

- .5 credit Health
- .5 credit Personal Fitness



Career Tech/World Lang/Fine Arts- 3 credits required

- World Language
- Fine Arts (Band, Orchestra, Chorus)
- Career/Technology

Keep in mind that most colleges require AT LEAST two levels of the same world language. The typical HS schedule allows room for both a fine arts and world language.

9th Grade End of Course (EOC) Tests

- End of Course Tests: Standardized Test in the state of Georgia
 - Algebra
 - Biology
- 20% of final course grade spring semester!!!

Final Exams

- Final Exams
 - Counts 10% of final grade if there is no EOC
 - Cannot be taken early
 - Given both semesters (December & May)

What is on a high school transcript?

- Record of all semester final grades
- Weighted and Unweighted GPA
- Identifying personal information
 - SS#, DOB, address
- Official document
 - Used by colleges, military, scholarship organizations and employers

*Middle School grades on transcript but not included in GPA

What is a GPA? And how to calculate?

○ Grade Point Average

○ A = 4.0 90-100

○ B = 3.0 80-89

○ C = 2.0 74-79

○ D = 1.0 70-73

○ F = 0 69 and below

○ Step 1- Assign each grade a numeric value.

○ A = 4, B = 3, C = 2, D = 1, F = 0

○ Step 2- Add all numeric values together

○ Divide by total number of grades/classes

What about Honors and AP Courses?

- Honors level courses
 - Add a .5 to GPA
 - A = 4.5, B = 3.5, etc.
- AP level courses (and world language level 4 and up)
 - Add 1.0 to GPA
 - A = 5, B = 4, etc.

Why take Honors and AP courses?

- Boost GPA and class rank
- Improve study skills
- Helps expand interests
- Improves work ethic and critical thinking skills
- Prepares you for SAT/ACT
- Familiarize student with college level work
- Advantage in college admissions
- May receive college credit

Different GPAs and when they are used

- Weighted

- On Lassiter transcript, includes Honors and AP Quality Points

- Unweighted

- On Lassiter transcript, removes Honors and AP Quality Points

- Academic

- Only Academic courses (removes electives such as weight training, band, ROTC, business, art)

- HOPE

- Only Academic classes, unweighted*
NOT ON LASSITER TRANSCRIPT!!

*3.5 for higher GPA for Honor Graduate designation

HOPE Scholarship Details

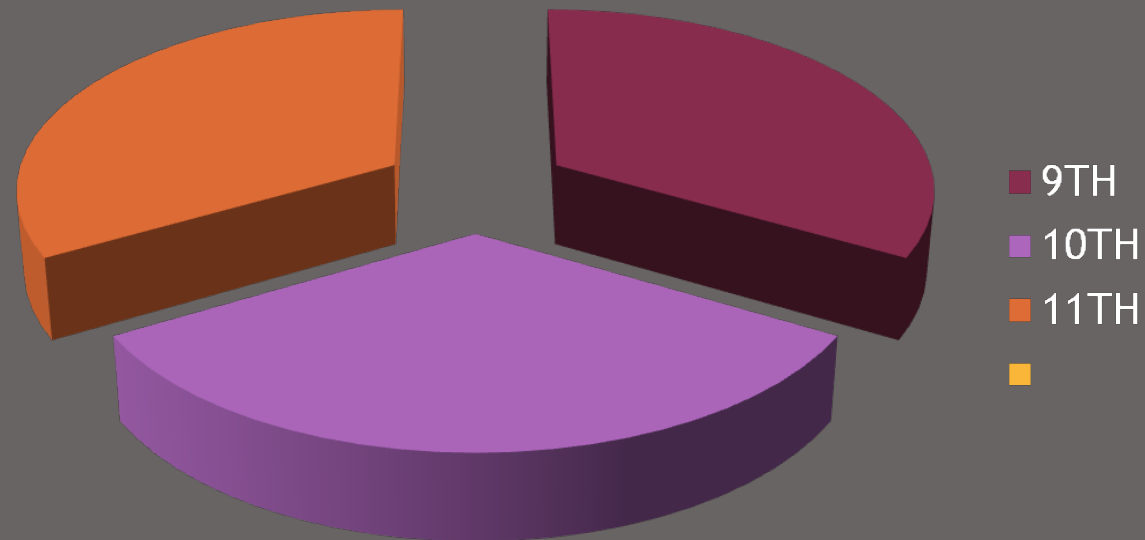
- 3.0 GPA required
- Academic, unweighted (but will add .5 for AP courses- up to a 4.0)
- Pays about 80-90% of tuition at a GA Public School
- Zell Miller requires a 3.7 GPA, 1200 SAT or 25 ACT
 - pays 100% tuition
- HOPE GPA is not finalized until graduation
- HOPE Rigor Requirements (4 credits)

Course Rigor

- Reach for the maximum level of coursework that is **APPROPRIATE** (based on teacher recommendation, student ability and student motivation)
- Colleges **ALWAYS** favor higher level courses
- Make sure you are comparing your academic profile to that of the college's admissions profile

- Don't wait until it's too late
 - Set up notifications if a grade drops to a certain point
