DO

DO NOT

- Copy and paste from websites or other sources.
- Turn in work written by someone else.
- Share quiz or test answers with another student.
- Use AI or other tools to complete assignments for you.
- Submit someone else's work as your own.

Consequences of Academic Integrity Violations

Occurrence	Consequence(s)	What to Expect
1 st offense	Teacher contacts parent Resubmit work for full credit	Your teacher will contact your parent or guardian to let them know there was a concern with an assignment and to keep them informed. In addition, you will be asked to redo the assignment, so it reflects your own work. You can earn full credit.
2 nd offense	Teacher contacts parent Resubmit work for ½ credit N in conduct on the report card	In addition to the parent contact details above and because the issue has happened more than once, the resubmission will receive partial credit.
3 rd offense (and any subsequent offenses)	Teacher contacts parent Admin contacts parent Automatic ZERO for the assignment U in conduct on the report card	In addition to the parent contact from the teacher, administration may contact your parent or guardian about the concern. We want everyone to understand the expectations. In addition, the assignment will receive a zero from this point further. Consequences will increase as the issue continues.
