Is my laptop ready?

Most AP exams are digital or have a digital component, so make sure your laptop is ready. Fully charge it before the exam and bring both your laptop and charger to the exam. Open the Bluebook app on your desktop prior to the exam—it will update automatically.

How can I prepare?

Many AP teachers are holding review sessions. See your teacher about AP review times. Also, you can also access review videos and sessions on AP Classroom.

What should I bring to my exam?

- Laptop & charger
- Black or blue pens and #2 Pencils
- Gov't issued photo ID or school ID
- College Board log in/password
- Calculator (approved exams only)
- Ruler/Straightedge (Physics only)

Do not bring cell phones, headphones, smart watches or review material!

What will my exam look like?

Fully digital: all exam questions including multiple choice and free-response will be digital & accessed on your school laptop.

Hybrid: multiple choice questions will be accessed on your school laptop. Free response questions will be answered in a physical test book provided, but the questions are on Bluebook.

Paper exams: No laptops necessary. All exam questions will be in a physical test book provided.

How do I log in to take my exam?

To take a digital or hybrid exam, you must log in with your College Board username and password. Write them down and bring them to your exam, as the Bluebook app doesn't support auto-fill and there's no time to reset your password on test day.

What time are my exams?

Morning exams will begin at 8:00 am and afternoon exams begin at 12:00 pm. Please arrive 30 mins prior to the start time. All exams will begin on time and no late admissions are allowed.
