

AP Test Day Information 2022

WHEN ARE AP TESTS? Monday, May 2 – Friday, May 13. See the page 2 for details.

WHERE WILL THE TESTS BE GIVEN? In the Aux Gym or another room at Hillgrove. All students are expected to arrive on time to the testing area (7:30am/11:30am).

WHAT IF I AM LATE TO MY EXAM? No one will be allowed to start testing late. You will forfeit your registration fee and not be able to take the test. There are no makeup tests.

WHAT IF I REGISTERED AND PAID TO TAKE A TEST, AND NOW CHANGED MY MIND AFTER ORIGINAL REGISTRATION WINDOW? If you change your mind, then YOU WILL FORFEIT the fee you paid. Please notify your AP teacher or Mr. Giles.

WHERE DO I GO IF I HAVE ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS? Go to the AP page on the Hillgrove website. All testing information is posted there. If you still have questions, then ask your AP teacher.

HOW DO I RECEIVE MY EXAM RESULTS? In July 2022, all AP score results will be delivered online. You must have a College Board account to have access to your scores. If you do not have account, then sign up at apcentral.collegeboard.org.

ARE THERE ANY SPECIAL THINGS THAT I CAN DO TO MAKE THE TESTING GO MORE SMOOTHLY?

- Report to the testing area on time (7:30am/11:30am).
- Bring a picture ID, #2 pencils (not mechanical), pens (blue or black), approved calculator, and hand sanitizer (must remain under desk).
- Pay careful attention to the directions given by the test administrators. They must make a formal report of any case involving students not following procedures. (Do NOT use an unapproved device, do NOT work on the wrong section of the test, etc.)
- Remember that all talking is forbidden during the test. If an administrator sees a student talking during the test, then he/she must report it. Do not put yourself at risk for having your score canceled.
- Do not bring inappropriate items to testing site. **Leave phones, smart watch, Fitbits, etc. at home!** There is also absolutely no food or drinks allowed in the testing site – this includes water!
- Backpacks, bags, pencil pouches, and purses are NOT allowed in the testing site – please leave all items at home.
- Make sure you get a good night's sleep and eat a healthy meal prior to your test.
- Please make sure you use the restroom prior to entering the testing site.

AP TESTING SCHEDULE - MAY 2022

Arrive on time! No late entries will be allowed. There are no makeup tests.

- For morning exams, if you complete your exam after your lunch period, then please make sure you eat lunch before reporting to your next class.
- For afternoon exams, make sure you eat lunch before reporting to exam site.
- Ending times are approximate estimations only.
