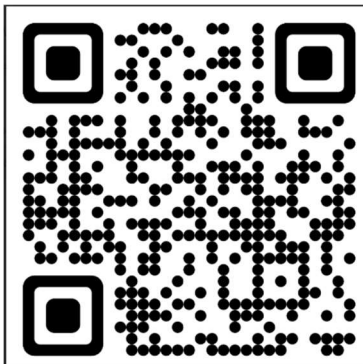
ShowTime Cheerleading: Tuesday 2:30-3:30 or 3:35-4:35

Tumbling: Wednesday 2:30-3:30 or 3:35-4:35

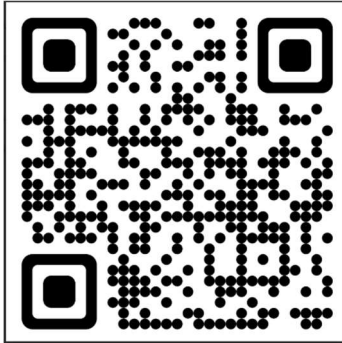
Students will learn the basics of tumbling. Great for body control and body awareness. Students will learn the proper stretching techniques and conditioning to become stronger.

Card games are both fun and educational because they engage players in strategic thinking, problem-solving, and social interaction, while also reinforcing skills like memory, math, and communication in a playful way.

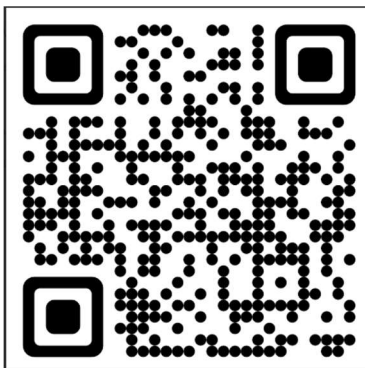


Line Dancing: (New)
