## MIDDLE SCHOOL SCHEDULE

- The middle school day is in session from approximately 9:15am until 4:15pm
- A "Traditional Schedule" is followed daily, meaning that all academic and elective classes are attended each day (total of 7 classes/periods)
- Students start the day by attending homeroom
- Students will travel to different classrooms throughout the day, usually on the same hallway
- Classes are 50 min. each



## ACADEMICS

- The academic subjects consist of Math, Science, Social Studies, Language Arts, ESOL and ELT
- Course placements are determined by using a combination of test data, existing student services (IEP, gifted) and previous school records.
- Requests for schedule changes are only made in rare circumstances (NOT because the student doesn't like the teacher, or to be with friends) and must occur within 10 days of the beginning of each semester

## EXTENDED LEARNING TIME (E.L.T.)



### ENGLISH FOR STUDENTS WITH OTHER LANGUAGES

Enriched learning that focuses on literacy in the areas of Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing

Students must be found eligible through a universal Wida Screener, or have ESOL services in Elementary school.

The lessons are grade-level appropriate, support all academic content areas, and designed per student's English Proficiency Level.

This class is an intensive program and is graded just as other classes.

This is a scheduled class; no students are pulled from their academic classes for ESOL.

## CONNECTIONS CLASSES

- Connection classes include Band, Orchestra, Chorus, Dance, PE, Health, Art, and Math Support
- · Students attend two connection classes each day
- · Fine Arts Connections classes will be year long
- General (non-fine arts) connection courses such as PE, Art and health are semester long and are not selected by student or parents. These courses are randomly assigned.
- Students who wish to enroll in band, orchestra, chorus, or the full year dance class are encouraged to register and be placed prior to the beginning of the sixth grade
- You cannot join Fine Arts in 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade, so if you're at all interested, register in 6<sup>th</sup> grade.



## COMMON MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENT CONCERNS

## HOMEWORK

- Each teacher posts assignments into CTLS
- A sixth-grade student can expect varying amounts of homework per night (45 min- 1hr), but when you manage your time well you can get it done
- Absent students should check CTLS for makeup work if possible. If CTLS cannot be accessed during absence, students must see each teacher the day they return for makeup work. Work not completed will result in a "zero"



## LUNCH

- 25 minutes
- A standard lunch includes a choice of entrée, 2-3 sides, and a varied milk selection
- Additional items are available for purchase (ice cream, chips, slushies and many more)
- Students eat with their class and teacher, but there are no assigned seats at the table. Teachers can also let their class eat outside or in the classroom
- Microwaves are not available for student use





## DRESS CODE

All students are expected to dress in a manner which demonstrates respect of the learning environment

Inappropriate graphics, caps/hats, and bandanas will not be permitted



Tank tops are not allowed

Jeans with holes above the knees may be worn as long as no skin is showing (you must wear something underneath)

Students are permitted to wear leggings however their shirt must cover their front and back

P.E. attire: sweatpants or shorts, loose t-shirt, and athletic shoes





## BUS INFORMATION

- Pick up times are usually between 8:20-8:45am depending on location of bus stop. Buses leave the school around 4:25pm in the afternoon
- Bus safety and rules are important to know and follow
- Routes are posted about a week before school begins and are also available online
- Students need to remember their bus number, route number, and bus lane number
- Students will need to know their bus information by the first day of school
- It is helpful for bus riders to begin riding the bus on the FIRST day of school!

- Students should use their agenda to keep track of homework, tests/quizzes, meetings, practices, and project due dates
- Develop a system for organizing your notebook(s). Options include separate notebooks for each class, or one large 3-ring binder with dividers and multiple folders. Find what works for you and stick with it
- Have a "neat" book bag to prevent missing or late assignments

## LOCKERS

- Students will be assigned a locker in homeroom. These lockers have a built-in combination lock which should be kept confidential
- Appropriate pictures and decorations are permitted on the inside
- There are scheduled locker breaks
- Rolling book bags will not fit in your locker

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\*Before 6th grade, it is a good idea to practice working a combination lock.
