
1. Open a web browser and navigate to http://bit.ly/certother or use the QR code.




2. Click **Save** to download and save the certificate to your local machine.

4. Click **Install Certificate** to import the certificate to your machine's registry.







- 5. Select Current User.
- 6. Click Next.




- 7. Select Place all certificates in the following store.
