AVID	Rising 10 <sup>th</sup> Graders Not currently in the program	Complete the required application
Dual Enrollment (Off-campus)	Rising 10th, 11th, and 12th graders	Must attend <a href="#">DE info session</a> , apply to college, turn in the packet to the counseling office, and meet with a counselor before the college's deadline.  Check the Campbell Counseling Page for more information about deadlines. 
Dual Enrollment (At Campbell)	Rising 12th graders	Seniors can apply to take Government (POLS 1101) at Campbell. You <b>MUST</b> apply to the college and follow the same steps as those planning to take DE off campus.
December Graduate	Eligible Seniors (Class of 2025)	Conference with a counselor, application submitted, parent permission. <b>Deadline: March 27</b>
Mentorship*	Rising Juniors & Seniors 3.0 GPA or higher	Must complete <a href="#">application</a> (available from Mr. Shaner, Room 703). <b>Deadline: Feb 14</b>
Minimum Day*	Rising Seniors Only 2nd semester ONLY	Must complete <a href="#">application</a> . <b>DUE: March 27</b>
Work Based Learning*	Rising Juniors & Seniors 2.5 GPA or higher	Must complete <a href="#">application</a> . <b>DUE: February 14th</b>

\*Students cannot be scheduled for Mentorship, Minimum Day, and WBL in the same semester
