

# Campbell High School Core & Elective Registration FAQ

2025-2026 SY

<b>When will core registration take place?</b>	Fall semester teachers made core placement recommendations for the 2025-2026 school year during December. Spring semester teachers will make core placement recommendations in February. Course descriptions and pre-requisites can be found on the CHS website in the Course Catalog.
<b>When is a waiver required?</b>	If there is a disagreement between the teacher and parent regarding the level of a core course the student is recommended. Student placement waivers may be submitted during Course Preview Week ONLY (March 26 <sup>th</sup> - April 2 <sup>nd</sup> ). Waivers are not available after course preview week or at the beginning of a new semester. Waivers DO NOT guarantee placement in the requested course.
<b>How do I register for online classes?</b>	Speak with your counselor to receive the CVA/GAVS Online Student Agreement Contract. Cobb Virtual Academy courses typically open up for registration in late April.
<b>When is elective registration?</b>	February 3 <sup>rd</sup> – 7 <sup>th</sup> for Rising 9 <sup>th</sup> graders. February 10 <sup>th</sup> – 14 <sup>th</sup> for rising 10 <sup>th</sup> and 11 <sup>th</sup> graders. Rising Seniors will complete elective registration during their Junior Advisement meeting with their counselor.
<b>What is the process for elective registration?</b>	Students will select 8 (eight) elective courses and number in order of preference on the elective registration form. <u>Elective courses are scheduled based on what course fits with a student's schedule and based on availability.</u> STUDENTS SHOULD CHOOSE ELECTIVE COURSES CAREFULLY. They can receive any of their 8 (eight) options or an elective course that allows them to complete a pathway. Requests for elective changes at the start of the semester CANNOT BE HONORED. Students who select courses for which they do not meet registration requirements will forfeit those elective choices.
<b>How do I register for elective classes that require an application?</b>	Students will note request on their elective registration form and complete an application. See below the application information: <b>Work Based Learning</b> (Juniors and Seniors) - Ms. Lewis, Room 701 Note: Students must have transportation & cannot be enrolled in Minimum Day or Mentorship. <b>Yearbook</b> (Juniors and Seniors) - Mr. Moyer, Room 904: Yr.-long commitment <b>AP Art</b> - Ms. Beard, Room 502: Yr. long commitment <b>Mentorship</b> (Juniors and Seniors) - Mr. Shaner, Room 703 Note: Student must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 <b>AVID</b> (All grade levels) - Ms. Johnson-Brownlee, Room 705/Ms. Bostic, Room 920
<b>How do I request Minimum Day?</b>	Minimum Day or Morning is only for Seniors during Spring semester. Minimum Day is NOT offered during Fall semester. Rising Seniors can request a Minimum Day application from their counselor; counselors must review student eligibility. Applications are due <b>April 2<sup>nd</sup></b> to counseling.
<b>How do I apply for Dual Enrollment?</b>	Students interested in taking Dual Enrollment classes in the Summer or Fall of 2025 must complete all the required CHS Dual Enrollment steps before April 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2025. Please choose your courses CAREFULLY and WISELY.
