Post-Secondary Options

1. Workforce/Apprenticeships
2. Military
3. Four-Year & Two-Year Colleges
4. Technical College or Trade School

Steps to Apply (General)

- 1. Create a list of 3-5 Colleges:** Research Programs, admission requirements (GPA, Test Score, etc.), and campus life
- 2. Check Admission Requirements and Deadlines:** SAT/ACT, Letters of Recommendation, Essays; Deadlines are hard deadlines
- 3. Take College Entrance Exams:** Students can register for the SAT and ACT for free if they qualify, see Counselor for fee waiver form
- 4. Submit Applications to College:** CommonApp, Common Black College App, GaFutures, or through college website
- 5. Send Transcript through SchoolLinks:** one-time \$2 fee for transcript to be sent, sent through SchoolLinks

Financial Aid

- Scholarships and Grants do not have to be repaid
- Loans are paid back with interest
- Students can complete the 2027-2028 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Scholarship search engines, college scholarships, work scholarships, community scholarships
- Be sure to check the OHS Scholarship Newsletter for OHS/local scholarships (Class of 2027 CTLS)

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- Opens October 1, 2026 for senior to complete with their parent/guardian
- Needs 2025 tax information and social security number
- This is the application for: HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarship Program, Federal Pell Grants, student loans, etc.
- Students/Parents will complete the 2027-2028 FAFSA

The HOPE Scholarship Program

Four-Year/Two-Year Degree

HOPE Scholarship:

- Minimum 3.0 HOPE GPA
- Graduate from GA High School, attending GA university/college
- Must have four academic rigor classes
- US Citizen or eligible non-citizen
- Covers up to 95% of tuition (USG)

Zell Miller Scholarship:

- Minimum 3.7 HOPE GPA
- Score 1200 on SAT or 25 on ACT in one sitting
- Graduate from GA High School, attending GA university/college
- Must have four academic rigor classes
- US Citizen or eligible non-citizen
- Covers 100% of tuition (USG)

Student's social security number must be on file with Osborne and GaFutures.

Students can check their HOPE GPA, academic rigor, and more information on www.gafutures.org.

Certificate or Diploma

HOPE Grant:

- No GPA Requirement
- Graduate from GA High School
- Enrolled in a certificate or diploma program at a technical college or university
- US Citizen or eligible non-citizen
- Maintain 2.0 college GPA
- Covers up to 100% of tuition

HOPE Career Grant:

- If a student is enrolled in eligible program, they receive a stipend based on the number of credit hours

Student's social security number must be on file with Osborne and GaFutures.

Students can check which programs qualify for HOPE Grant & Career Grant on www.gafutures.org.

Federal Pell Grants

- A need-based grant from the federal government to help pay for college
- Does NOT have to be repaid
- There is not a GPA requirement to be eligible- this is all need-based
- Award amounts vary each year based on financial need and enrollment status
- Students must complete the FAFSA to determine Eligibility

Can award up to \$7,395 per school year (2027-2028 award amount)

FAFSA VS. GSFAPP

GSFAPP is completed through GaFutures.

It only takes a few minutes.

Tax documents not required.



FINANCIAL AID APPLICATIONS COMPARISON CHART

	FAFSA	GSFAPP
Federal Aid (Pell Grant, Student Loans, etc)	YES	NO- Students will need to complete the FAFSA for Federal Aid
State Aid (HOPE/Zell Miller)	YES- Students do not need to complete the GSFAPP if they complete FAFSA	YES
Do I need Tax Information to complete this?	YES- This is how Pell Grants and Student Loans are determined	NO- State Aid is not based on Financial Need.
Do I need a Social Security Number?	YES	YES
How often do I complete application?	Every year after October 1st.	This application is good for 10 years.
