DRESS CODE



- Shirts and pants should cover undergarments at all times.
- Tank-tops, halter-tops, sleeveless shirts and spaghetti-strap-tops must be worn with a jacket.
- Shirts should not reveal or expose the chest area or cleavage. Shirts should also be long enough not to expose mid-section, even when arms are raised.
- Recommended length for skirts/shorts is at or below mid-thigh; skirts and shorts must be visible and fully cover the backside at all times.
- Slippers and pajama pants are not permitted.
 - Proper shoes must be worn at all times.
- Caps, hats, bandanas, hoods covering the head are not to be worn in the school building during the school day.
- Clothing and ornamentation should not display activities or substances illegal for minors, suggestive phrases, markings, or profanities.
