Digital Learning Day

The Cobb County School District will have a **Digital Learning Day on Monday, August 17**. Students will not report to campus and will complete classwork from home. Lassiter teachers will post instructions in CTLS by the start of the school day. Please encourage your student to check each class and stay on track with their work.

ASE – Academic Support and Enrichment

The first day of **ASE (Academic Support and Enrichment) will be Wednesday, August 19**. ASE occurs between 1st and 2nd periods every Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday. This is dedicated time for your student to receive remediation or extension in designated courses. Students can see their ASE room location under Period 9 "Curriculum Advisement" in StudentVue. Students who don't have access to StudentVue will be assisted during the transition to ASE on Wednesday, August 19.

Expect Respect

On Tuesday, August 25, Lassiter High School will begin implementing *Expect Respect*, the districtwide bullying prevention program. This initiative—along with class meetings, daily announcements, and student handbook reviews—reinforces our commitment to creating a safe, welcoming, and respectful school environment where every student can thrive.

We invite our families to partner with us by encouraging students to follow the outlined steps when they experience disrespectful words or actions from another student. Together, we can help ensure that Lassiter remains a place where all students feel valued, supported, and ready to learn.

Over the next few months, students will learn how to identify, stop, and report types of bullying behavior. The date and topic for our lessons are as follows:

- August 25 - Introduction to “Expect Respect”.
- September 1 - Bullying – Define, Identify and Report
- September 8 – Racism/Hate Speech - Define, Identify and Report
- September 15 - Athletic events – Good Sportsmanship and Spectator Behavior
- October 6 - Cyber Bullying and Positive Online Presence
- October 20 – Violence Prevention
- November 10 - Closing

We welcome our families to contact the school with any concerns about bullying behavior. We appreciate your ongoing support and discussions with your child as we work together to create a positive school community.

Classroom Lessons with Counselors

Lassiter School Counselors hosted classroom lessons in all 12th grade English courses this week. Next week, they will present in all 9th grade English courses.
