- By SY26, increase growth by 2 percentage points, for students scoring at the proficient and distinguished levels, as evidenced by the state assessments.
- By SY28, increase graduation rate from 87% to 88% as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.

Fair Oaks Elementary goals for Student Achievement:

**Goal #1 ELA:** The percentage of **1**<sup>st</sup> **grade** students scoring near target and prepared will increase by a minimum of 30% from Fall 2025 baseline to Spring 2026, as measured by the 2025-2026 Beacon Assessment.

<u>Goal #2 Math</u>: The percentage of 1<sup>st</sup> grade students scoring near target or prepared on the Math Beacon Assessment will increase from 22% in Winter 2025 (Kindergarten) to 25% in Spring 2026.

- ✓ Student will practice counting to 120 using a 100s chart every night.
