

Our Goals for Students Achievement District Improvement Plan goals

- By SY29, increase by 2 percentage points the number of students performing at the proficient and distinguished levels, as evidenced by state assessments.
- By SY29, increase graduation rate from 89% to 91% as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.

Fair Oaks Elementary goals for Student Achievement:

Goal #1 ELA: 3rd-5th grade students scoring proficient or advance will increase by 3% measured by the 2026-2027 Georgia ELA Milestones Assessment.

Goal #2 Math: The percentage of 3-5 Grade students scoring proficient and distinguished on the Math Milestones Assessment will increase from 45.6% in May 2026 to 50% in May 2027.

Teachers, Parents, and Students – Together for Success

Teachers: Fair Oaks Elementary teachers will work with students and their families to develop students' love of learning. The focus of our key connections with families will be:

1. Teachers will provide independent reading books for students to read at home with their families.
2. Teachers will provide fact fluency resources so students can practice their math facts at home with their families.
3. Teachers will provide a weekly CTLS post for parents about upcoming learning.

At Home: Fair Oaks Elementary School parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' academic understanding. Families may have other ideas to add to this list:

1. Parents will listen to their student read his/her independent reading books.
2. Parents will help students practice their math facts at home.
3. Parents will review the weekly CTLS post and will be given the opportunity to ask teachers questions to better support their child at home.

Students: Fair Oaks Elementary School students joined staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed in school:

1. Students will practice reading their independent reading books at home.
2. Students will practice math facts at home.
3. Students will read the weekly CTLS post with their parents.
