# Teachers, Parents, and Students-Together for Success

## South Cobb Teachers

Will provide strategies for all students in EOC courses

Will provide remediation for students who fail to meet the standards through Edmentum

Will participate in Literacy Block to encourage reading and writing skills.

## South Cobb Families

Will familiarize themselves with EOC testing and what it means for their student

Will encourage their student to achieve highly and use remediation as needed.

Will encourage daily reading for 15-20 minutes with their children

## South Cobb Students

Will help to educate their families on what EOC testing is and will prepare adequately prior to the exam.

Will be forth coming with progress and and challenges. Will seek guidance/assistance from teachers and/or guardians when needed. Will use remediation as necessary.

Will spend 15-20 mintes a day reading to improve literacy skills.

## District Goals for Student Achievement

- Increase student performance in all core content areas by 2% annually as measured by achievement data.
- CCSD will increase the participation rate of families and communities engaging in services/programs by 10% as measured by CLTS Parent data, survey results & web view module.
- By 2024, we will implement the professional learning framework to meet the needs of all students to ensure alignment with the superintendent priorities as measured by professional learning opportunities, surveys, and student achievement.
- By the end of the 2025 school year, every school will have identified practices and resources that support student success as measured by student achievement, perception and discipline data.

## South Cobb's Goal(s) for Student Achievement

- Goal #1:** To increase school performance on ALL end-of-course assessments by 3% at the proficiency level (Level III and IV) as measured by the EOC assessments given over the 2022-2023 school year in (Algebra I, American Literature, Biology, U.S. History)
- Goal #2:** To increase the percentage of students reading at or above grade level from 53% based on the SY2022-2023 Reading Inventory data to 56% by the end of the 2023-2024 school year.
- Goal #3:** To increase the number of students scoring levels 3 and 4 on the Algebra EOC exam by 3% by the end of May 2024.
- Goal #4:** To improve the school climate by reducing the number of Out of School Suspension days (OSS) and Unexcused absences (AUX) from the 2022-2023 SY to the 2023-2024 SY by 5%.
