

Our Goals for Students Achievement District Improvement Plan goals:

- By SY29, increase by 2 percentage points the number of students performing at the proficient and distinguished levels, as evidenced by state assessments.
- By SY29, increase graduation rate from 89% to 91% as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.

Fair Oaks Elementary goals for Student Achievement:

Goal #1 ELA: Kindergarten: 80% of kindergarten students will be developing, on track, or above grade level as measured by Amira by Spring 2027. The percentage of **1st grade and 2nd** students scoring near target and prepared will increase by a minimum of 30% from Fall 2026 baseline to Spring 2027, as measured by the 2026-2027 Beacon Assessment.

Goal #2: Math: Kindergarten– 85% of kindergarten students will score near target or prepared on the Math Beacon Assessment in Spring 2027. **1st Grade –** The percentage of 1st grade students scoring near target or prepared on the Math Beacon Assessment will increase from 81% in Spring 2026 to 84% Spring 2027. **2nd Grade –** The percentage of 2nd grade students scoring near target or prepared on the Math

Teachers, Parents, and Students – Together for Success

Teachers: Fair Oaks Elementary teachers will work with students and their families to develop students' love of learning. The focus of our key connections with families will be:

1. Teachers will provide parents with decodable passages to read with their children.
2. Teachers will provide parents with fluency resources so that students can complete math practice at home.
3. Teachers will provide a weekly CTLS post for parents about upcoming learning.

At Home: Fair Oaks Elementary School parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' academic understanding. Families may have other ideas to add to this list:

1. Parents will listen to their child read decodable passages and ask them questions about what they read.
2. Parents will help students practice their math fluency at home.
3. Parents will review the weekly CTLS post and will be given the opportunity to ask teachers questions to better support their child at home.

Students: Fair Oaks Elementary School students joined staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed in school:

1. Students will practice reading their decodable passages at home.
2. Students will practice their math fluency at home.
3. Students will read the weekly CTLS post with their parents.
