

Funding

- Tuition and Mandatory Fees are 100% Paid by DE Funding for the first 30 credit hours
- Course specific fees may apply and are the responsibility of the student

These fees usually apply to Technical Programs / Courses. Fee amounts can vary, Ex: Welding, Automotive, Certified Nursing Assistant, etc.

- Textbook and/or Access Codes are provided by the college Library
- Students can track their funding in GA Futures
- Financial Aid options are available after 30 hours






